## **HOUSE BILL No. 5085**

A bill to amend 1909 PA 279, entitled "The home rule city act,"

by amending section 4-j (MCL 117.4j) and by adding section 4s.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4-j. Each city may in its charter provide FOR ANY OF THE 2 FOLLOWING:
- 3 (1) For the establishment of any department that it may deem
- 4 CONSIDER necessary for the general welfare of the city, and for the
- 5 separate incorporation thereof: Provided, however, That these
- 6 provisions OF THOSE DEPARTMENTS. HOWEVER, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN
