HOUSE BILL No. 5329

September 10, 2009, Introduced by Reps. Segal, Bolger, Espinoza, Walsh, Liss and Barnett and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to accept and convey certain real property in Calhoun county; to prescribe certain conditions for the acceptance and conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, subject to and contingent upon the conveyance of the
- 3 property to Legion Villa, inc., a nonprofit corporation, as
- 4 provided in subsection (2), shall accept from Legion Villa, inc.,
- for consideration of \$1.00, certain real property that was
- originally conveyed to the American Legion hospital, inc., in the
- 7 May 15, 1975 quitclaim deed to the American Legion hospital, inc.,
- 8 recorded in Liber 1062, page 896, Calhoun county records, and is
- located in Battle Creek township, Calhoun county, Michigan, and

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- 1 more particularly described as:
- 2 A parcel of land in the east 1/2 of the northeast 1/4 of
- 3 section 5, T2S, R8W, Battle Creek township, Calhoun county, ss:
- 4 Beginning at the east 1/4 post of section 5, T2S, R8W, thence
- 5 along the 1/4 line south 89° 08' 13" west 1327.57 feet to the
- 6 south-northeast 1/8 post, thence north 0° 51' 07" west 2458.65 feet
- 7 to the north-northeast 1/8 post, thence north 89° 29' 30" east
- 8 along the section line 662.06 feet to a point from which the
- 9 northeast corner of section 5 bears north 89° 29' 30" east 662.06
- 10 feet, thence south 0° 53' 30" east 495 feet, thence north 89° 29'
- 11 30" east 662.75 feet to a point on the east line of section 5 from
- 12 which the northeast corner bears north 0° 56' west 495 feet, thence
- 13 south 0° 56' east 1955.53 feet to the place of beginning and
- 14 containing 67.189 acres, subject to rights of way of record.
- 15 (2) The state administrative board, on behalf of the state,
- 16 after receiving the conveyance authorized in subsection (1), shall
- 17 convey to Legion Villa, inc., formerly known as the American Legion
- 18 hospital, inc., for consideration of \$1.00, the real property
- 19 described in subsection (1).
- 20 (3) The description of the parcel in subsection (1) is
- 21 approximate and for purposes of the conveyances is subject to
- 22 adjustment as the state administrative board or attorney general
- 23 considers necessary by survey or other legal description.
- 24 (4) Any conveyance of property under subsection (2) shall
- 25 provide for both of the following:
- 26 (a) The property shall be used exclusively for health care
- 27 facilities, except that Legion Villa, inc. may sell or lease any

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- 1 portion of the property if the revenue derived from the sale or
- 2 lease is dedicated to the continued operation, maintenance, or
- 3 capital requirements of the health care facilities located on the
- 4 property.
- 5 (b) Upon termination of the use described in subdivision (a)
- 6 or in the event of use for any other purpose, the state may reenter
- 7 and repossess the property, terminating the grantee's estate in the
- 8 property. If the grantee disputes the state's exercise of its right
- 9 of reentry and fails to promptly deliver possession of the property
- 10 to the state, the attorney general, on behalf of the state, may
- 11 bring an action to quiet title to, and regain possession of, the
- 12 property. If the state reenters and repossesses the property, the
- 13 state has no liability for any improvements made on the property.
- 14 (5) The conveyance authorized by subsection (2) shall be by
- 15 quitclaim deed or other instrument approved by the attorney
- 16 general.
