

# SENATE BILL No. 278

February 19, 2009, Introduced by Senator SWITALSKI and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1319.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 1319. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF  
2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT ITS POLICIES  
3 CONCERNING A PUPIL'S ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN  
4 INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

5           (A) A REQUIREMENT FOR COUNSELING FOR ALL ATHLETES CONCERNING  
6 THE RISKS AND CONSEQUENCES OF USING A PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING  
7 SUBSTANCE.

8           (B) A REQUIREMENT THAT, AS PART OF UNDERGOING A PHYSICAL  
9 EXAMINATION THAT IS REQUIRED BEFORE PARTICIPATION, A PUPIL MUST  
10 UNDERGO SCREENING FOR USE OF PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING SUBSTANCES BY

1 THE PUPIL.

2 (2) NOT LATER THAN JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL  
3 DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL  
4 SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH A REPORT OF THE NUMBER  
5 AND PERCENTAGE OF PUPILS WHO HAD THE SCREENING UNDER SUBSECTION  
6 (1)(B) FOR THE PRECEDING SCHOOL YEAR WHO TESTED POSITIVE FOR 1 OR  
7 MORE PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING SUBSTANCES. TO THE EXTENT THAT THE  
8 INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE TO THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS, THE  
9 REPORT ALSO SHALL INDICATE THE NUMBER AND PERCENTAGE OF POSITIVE  
10 RESULTS THAT WERE THE RESULT OF A PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING SUBSTANCE  
11 THAT WAS PRESCRIBED BY A HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL. THE DEPARTMENT  
12 OF COMMUNITY HEALTH SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE A MODEL  
13 REPORTING FORM THAT MAY BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS  
14 SUBSECTION.

15 (3) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "PERFORMANCE-ENHANCING  
16 SUBSTANCE" MEANS A SUBSTANCE INCLUDED ON THE LIST OF PERFORMANCE-  
17 ENHANCING SUBSTANCES UNDER SECTION 1318.
