

# SENATE BILL No. 690

July 15, 2009, Introduced by Senator BROWN and referred to the Committee on Campaign and Election Oversight.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 932c.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 932C. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT PROVIDE COMPENSATION TO  
2        ANOTHER PERSON FOR REGISTERING INDIVIDUALS TO VOTE THAT IS BASED  
3        UPON ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

4        (A) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS A PERSON REGISTERS TO  
5        VOTE.

6        (B) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS A PERSON REGISTERS TO VOTE  
7        IN A PARTICULAR POLITICAL PARTY.

8        (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY  
9        PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR A FINE OF

1 NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
