## **SENATE BILL No. 1136**

- ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.43501 TO
- 324.43561, MAY KILL A SWINE RUNNING AT LARGE ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE
