- 1 Sec. 8317. (1) An application submitted under this part shall
- 2 be accompanied by the following application fee:
- 3 (a) For a commercial applicator certification, \$75.00.
- 4 (b) For a private agricultural applicator certification,
- 5 \$50.00 until September 30, 2012 2015 and \$10.00 after September 30,
- 7 (c) For a commercial registered applicator, \$45.00.
- 8 (d) For a private registered applicator, \$50.00 until
- 9 September 30, <del>2012-</del>**2015** and \$10.00 after September 30, <del>2012.</del>**2015.**
- 10 (2) Certificates for commercial applicators, private
- 11 agricultural applicators, and registered applicators shall be valid
- 12 for a period of time of not less than 3 years to be established by

- 2 (3) The license application fee for a commercial applicator
- 3 license is \$100.00. The license expires annually on December 31.
- 4 (4) The registration application fee for the registration of
- 5 pesticides sold, offered for sale, exposed for sale, or distributed

- 7 (5) The license application fee for a restricted use pesticide
- 8 dealer's license is \$100.00. The license expires annually on

- 10 (6) The license application fee for an agricultural pesticide
- 11 dealer's license is \$100.00. The license expires annually on

- 13 (7) Application fees submitted under this section are not
- 14 refundable.
- 15 (8) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (1)(B)
- 16 AND (D), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WAIVE ANY FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED
