

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 5365**

A bill to make, supplement, adjust, and consolidate appropriations for various state departments and agencies, capital outlay, the judicial branch, and the legislative branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the various state departments and agencies, the judicial branch, and the legislative

11 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state resources

14 government for fiscal year 2012-2013 is \$0.

21 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

22 Sec. 1201. It is the intent of the legislature to provide  
23 appropriations for the fiscal year ending on September 30, 2014 for

1 the line items listed in part 1. The fiscal year 2013-2014  
2 appropriations are anticipated to be the same as those for fiscal  
3 year 2012-2013, excluding appropriations designated as 1-time  
4 appropriations and adjusting for changes in caseload and related  
5 costs, federal fund match rates, economic factors, and available  
6 revenue.
