## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 5676

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 19708 (MCL 324.19708), as amended by 2010 PA 232.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 19708. (1) Subject to subsections (2), (3), and (4), the
- 2 state treasurer shall transfer money in the fund as follows:
- 3 (a) In aggregate, not more than \$710,000,000.00
- 4 \$290,000,000.00 of the money in the fund shall be deposited into
- 5 the state water pollution control revolving fund created in section
- 6 16a of the shared credit rating act, 1985 PA 227, MCL 141.1066a.
- 7 (b) In aggregate, not more than \$290,000,000.00
- 8 \$710,000,000.00 of the money in the fund shall be deposited into
- 9 the strategic water quality initiatives fund created in section

- **1** 5204.
- 2 (2) Money in the fund may be used by the department of
- 3 treasury to pay for the cost of issuing bonds and the costs
- 4 incurred under section 19703(3).
- 5 (3) Bonds that are directly deposited into the state water
- 6 pollution control revolving fund or strategic water quality
- 7 initiatives fund as authorized by section 19703 shall be taken into
- 8 account for the purpose of determining the allocation and transfer
- 9 of money set forth in subsection (1).
- 10 (4) Not later than 2 years after the effective date of the
- 11 amendatory act that added this subsection, DECEMBER 14, 2012, the
- 12 auditor general shall conduct an audit of the fund to assure that
- 13 the money in the fund has been expended in compliance with law. Not
- 14 later than 4 years after the effective date of the amendatory act
- 15 that added this subsection, DECEMBER 14, 2014, the auditor general
- 16 shall update its initial audit to assure that money in the fund has
- 17 been expended in compliance with law.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 19 unless all of the following bills of the 96th Legislature are
- 20 enacted into law:
