## SENATE BILL NO. 210

A bill to amend 2000 PA 274, entitled "Large carnivore act,"

by amending section 22 (MCL 287.1122).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 22. (1) Sections 4, 5, and 6 do not apply to any of the
- 2 following:
- 3 (a) An animal control shelter or animal protection shelter
- 4 TEMPORARILY IN POSSESSION OF A LARGE CARNIVORE FOR NOT MORE THAN 45
- 5 DAYS.
- 6 (b) A person licensed or approved by the department of natural
- 7 resources of this state or by the United States fish and wildlife
- 8 service of the United States department of the interior. This
- 9 subdivision does not apply to a person in possession of 1 or more

- 1 black bears under the authority of a permit to hold wildlife in
- 2 captivity issued by the department of natural resources.
- 3 (c) A zoological park approved or accredited by the American
- 4 zoo and aquarium association.
- 5 (d) A person approved by the association of sanctuaries or the
- 6 American sanctuary association.
- 7 (C) (e) A law enforcement officer acting under the authority
- 8 of this act.
- 9 (D) (f) A veterinarian temporarily in possession of a large
- 10 carnivore to provide veterinary care for or humanely euthanize the
- 11 large carnivore.
- 12 (2) Sections 4, 5, 6(1)(d) to (5)(d), 8, and 14(3) do not
- 13 apply to a person who is not a resident of this state and who is in
- 14 this state only for the purpose of travel between locations outside
- 15 of this state.
- 16 (3) Subject to subsection (2), this act does SECTIONS 3, 4,
- 17 AND 6 DO not apply to a person who meets all of the following
- 18 requirements:
- 19 (a) Is conducting a for-profit or nonprofit business that
- 20 meets both of the following requirements:
- 21 (i) The primary purpose of the business is the presentation of
- 22 animals including large carnivores to the public for education, or
- 23 exhibition, OR CONSERVATION purposes.
- 24 (ii) The business is not conducted in connection with another
- 25 business as a means of attracting customers to that other business.
- 26 (b) Is a CLASS A LICENSEE OR class C licensee that possesses
- 27 and maintains a CLASS A LICENSE OR class C license under 9 C.F.R.

- 1 CFR 1.1 -AND IS APPROVED OR ACCREDITED BY 1 OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (i) A ZOOLOGICAL PARK APPROVED OR ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN
- 3 ZOO AND AQUARIUM ASSOCIATION OR BY THE ZOOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION OF
- 4 AMERICA.
- 5 (ii) A PERSON APPROVED BY THE AMERICAN SANCTUARY ASSOCIATION.
- 6 (c) Meets or exceeds all standards, including but not limited
- 7 to standards for training, housing, care, and transport of large
- 8 carnivores, required of a CLASS A LICENSEE OR class C licensee
- 9 under 9 C.F.R. CFR 1.1.
- (d) Does not allow a patron to do any of the following:
- 11 (i) Come into direct contact with a large carnivore.
- 12 (ii) Come into close enough contact with a large carnivore over
- 13 20 weeks of age so as to place the patron in jeopardy of being
- 14 harmed by the large carnivore.
- 15 (e) Does not sell large carnivores, except to another person
- 16 that meets the requirements of this subsection.
- 17 (f) Does not breed ONLY BREEDS large carnivores IF APPROVED OR
- 18 ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN ZOO AND AQUARIUM ASSOCIATION OR BY THE
- 19 ZOOLOGICAL ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA.
- 20 (4) This act does not apply to a circus.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 22 unless Senate Bill No. 703 of the 96th Legislature is enacted into
- 23 law.
