HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 439

A bill to amend 2008 PA 260, entitled "Guardianship assistance act,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 722.876), as amended by 2009 PA 15.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE
- 2 department shall not provide guardianship assistance after 1 of the
- 3 following occurs:
- 4 (a) The child reaches 18 years of age.
- 5 (b) The department determines that the guardian is no longer
- 6 legally responsible for support of the child.
- 7 (c) The department determines that the child is no longer
- 8 receiving any support from the relative guardian.
- 9 (d) The death of the child.

- 1 (e) The child is adopted by the guardian or another individual
- 2 under the Michigan adoption code, chapter X of the probate code,
- 3 MCL 710.21 to 710.70, or the adoption laws of any other state or
- 4 country.
- 5 (f) The guardianship is terminated by order of the court
- 6 having jurisdiction in the guardianship proceeding.
- 7 (g) The death of the guardian.
- 8 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE EXTENDED GUARDIANSHIP
- 9 ASSISTANCE UNTIL THE YOUTH REACHES THE AGE OF 21 IF THE YOUTH MEETS
- 10 THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH IN THE YOUNG ADULT VOLUNTARY FOSTER CARE
- 11 ACT.
- 12 (3) (2) The department shall send notice of termination of
- 13 guardianship assistance under this section by mail to the guardian
- 14 at the guardian's current or last known address and to the court
- 15 with jurisdiction over the guardianship case. Notice mailed under
- 16 this subsection shall include a statement of the department's
- 17 reason for termination.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 19 unless Senate Bill No. 435 of the 96th Legislature is enacted into
- 20 law.
