## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 723

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 10301.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 10301. (1) THE DEPARTMENT MAY CREATE, OPERATE, AND
- 2 MAINTAIN THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY, WHICH SHALL CONTAIN THE
- 3 DIRECTIVES OF VOLUNTARY REGISTRANTS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF THIS
- 4 STATE. THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY SHALL BE CREATED, OPERATED, AND
- 5 MAINTAINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT.
- 6 (2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY BY CONTRACT DELEGATE THE CREATION,
- 7 OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF A PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY TO A PEACE
- 8 OF MIND REGISTRY ORGANIZATION CONTINGENT UPON THE PEACE OF MIND
- 9 REGISTRY ORGANIZATION INCURRING ALL OF THE COST RELATED TO DESIGN,
- 10 MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE THE REGISTRY.

- 1 (3) BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLY TO A DIRECTIVE:
- 2 (A) A DIRECTIVE MAY BE SUBMITTABLE THROUGH THE UNITED STATES
- 3 MAIL, OR THROUGH UPLOADED PORTABLE DOCUMENT FORMAT (PDF) OR ANOTHER
- 4 SECURE ELECTRONIC FORMAT AS DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 5 (B) A DIRECTIVE SHALL CONTAIN A SIGNATURE LINE FOR THE
- 6 REGISTRANT.
- 7 (4) THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY SHALL MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING
- 8 REQUIREMENTS:
- 9 (A) BE ACCESSIBLE TO REGISTRANTS, HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS, AND
- 10 THE DEPARTMENT BY WAY OF A DESIGNATED USER IDENTIFICATION AND
- 11 PASSWORD.
- 12 (B) STORE ALL AN INDIVIDUAL'S DIRECTIVE. HOWEVER, THE MOST
- 13 RECENTLY SIGNED DIRECTIVE SUPERSEDES ANY EARLIER DIRECTIVE.
- 14 (C) PROVIDE ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO STORED DIRECTIVES ON A
- 15 CONTINUOUS BASIS AT NO COST TO THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS AND ALLOW
- 16 HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS TO TRANSMIT DIRECTIVES INTO THEIR RESPECTIVE
- 17 ELECTRONIC MEDICAL RECORDS.
- 18 (D) PROVIDE ELECTRONIC STORAGE AND ACCESS TO DIRECTIVES
- 19 SUBMITTED AT NO COST TO THE REGISTRANT.
- 20 (E) INCLUDE A UNIQUE IDENTIFIER-SEARCHABLE DATABASE,
- 21 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE LAST 4 DIGITS OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S
- 22 SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER AND THE INDIVIDUAL'S DATE OF BIRTH AND
- 23 ADDRESS.
- 24 (5) THE DEPARTMENT, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AND THE DEPARTMENT
- 25 OF HUMAN SERVICES SHALL EACH PROVIDE ON ITS PUBLIC WEBSITE
- 26 INFORMATION ON DIRECTIVES AND THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY. THE
- 27 DEPARTMENT, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN

- 1 SERVICES SHALL PROMOTE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE ADVANTAGES OF
- 2 CREATING DIRECTIVES AND THE AVAILABILITY OF THE REGISTRY.
- 3 (6) THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY SHALL SATISFY ALL OF THE
- 4 FOLLOWING CONDITIONS TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT:
- 5 (A) MAINTAIN A RECORD OF EACH INDIVIDUAL WHO FILES A DIRECTIVE
- 6 TO BE STORED IN THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY AND MAKE THE RECORD
- 7 AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 8 (B) CREATE AND PROVIDE FORMS FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A
- 9 DIRECTIVE.
- 10 (C) CREATE AND PROVIDE FORMS FOR THE REVOCATION OF A
- 11 DIRECTIVE.
- 12 (7) THE DEPARTMENT AND THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY ORGANIZATION
- 13 SHALL ENSURE THE PRIVACY AND SECURITY OF ALL DOCUMENTS AND
- 14 INFORMATION SUBMITTED TO, TRANSMITTED FROM, OR STORED IN THE PEACE
- 15 OF MIND REGISTRY. THE DEPARTMENT AND ANY PERSON WHO ACCESSES THE
- 16 PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF
- 17 THIS ACT AND ANY OTHER LAW OF THIS STATE OR FEDERAL LAW
- 18 ESTABLISHING PRIVACY AND SECURITY STANDARDS APPLICABLE TO HEALTH OR
- 19 OTHER PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION.
- 20 (8) INFORMATION IN THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY SHALL NOT BE
- 21 ACCESSED OR USED FOR ANY PURPOSE UNRELATED TO DECISION MAKING FOR
- 22 HEALTH CARE OR DISPOSITION OF HUMAN REMAINS, EXCEPT THAT THE
- 23 INFORMATION MAY BE USED SOLELY BY THE DEPARTMENT OR ITS DESIGNEE
- 24 FOR STATISTICAL OR ANALYTICAL PURPOSES IF THE INDIVIDUAL'S IDENTITY
- 25 IS NOT REVEALED AND ALL PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION REMAINS
- 26 CONFIDENTIAL.
- 27 (9) THE DEPARTMENT OR ITS DESIGNEE SHALL PROVIDE BOTH OF THE

- 1 FOLLOWING TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO FILES A DIRECTIVE WITH THE PEACE OF
- 2 MIND REGISTRY TO BE STORED IN THE REGISTRY:
- 3 (A) A WALLET-SIZED CARD INDICATING THAT THE HOLDER HAS A
- 4 DIRECTIVE IN THE REGISTRY.
- 5 (B) AN ELECTRONIC MAIL MESSAGE OR POSTCARD INDICATING
- 6 CONFIRMATION OF THE REGISTRATION OF A DIRECTIVE.
- 7 (10) BY JANUARY 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT OR PEACE OF
- 8 MIND ORGANIZATION, AS APPLICABLE, SHALL REPORT TO THE STANDING
- 9 COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE ON HEALTH
- 10 POLICY STATING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CURRENT AND NEW REGISTRANTS WHO
- 11 HAVE SUBMITTED DIRECTIVES DURING THE PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.
- 12 (11) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE RULES UNDER THE
- 13 ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES ACT OF 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 TO
- 14 24.328, TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF
- 15 THIS SECTION.
- 16 (12) A PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY ORGANIZATION, WITH WHICH THE
- 17 DEPARTMENT HAS CONTRACTED UNDER SUBSECTION (2), AND ITS EMPLOYEES
- 18 ARE IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY ARISING FROM THE ACCURACY OR
- 19 CONTENT OF THE REGISTRY, EXCEPT IN THE CASE OF WILLFUL NEGLIGENCE
- 20 OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE.
- 21 (13) A DIRECTIVE THAT WAS FILED WITH AND STORED IN THE PEACE
- 22 OF MIND REGISTRY SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE OF GREATER LEGAL
- 23 WEIGHT OR VALIDITY SOLELY BY VIRTUE OF THAT FILING AND STORAGE.
- 24 (14) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 25 (A) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH.
- 26 (B) "DIRECTIVE" MEANS A DOCUMENT THAT IS REGISTERED OR FILED
- 27 WITH THE PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY AS PROVIDED IN THIS ACT AND THAT IS

- 7 DECISION FOR THE DONOR UNDER THE REVISED UNIFORM ANATOMICAL GIFT
- 8 LAW, SECTIONS 10101 TO 10123.
- 9 (C) "HEALTH CARE PROVIDER" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (i) A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL LICENSED, REGISTERED, OR OTHERWISE
- 11 AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN A HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER PARTS 170, 172, [OR
- 12 175, OR A LAW OF ANOTHER STATE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO PART 170, 172, OR 175.
- 13 (ii) A HEALTH FACILITY OR AGENCY LICENSED OR CERTIFIED UNDER
- 14 ARTICLE 17 [OR A LAW OF ANOTHER STATE SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR TO ARTICLE
- 15 (D) "PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY" OR "REGISTRY" MEANS AN INTERNET
- 16 WEBSITE CONTAINING ACCESS TO DIRECTIVES AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT.
- 17 (E) "PEACE OF MIND REGISTRY ORGANIZATION" MEANS AN
- 18 ORGANIZATION CERTIFIED OR RECERTIFIED BY THE SECRETARY OF THE
- 19 UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AS A
- 20 QUALIFIED ORGAN PROCUREMENT ORGANIZATION UNDER 42 USC 273(B), OR
- 21 ITS SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION.
- 22 (F) "SIGN" MEANS THAT, WITH THE PRESENT INTENT TO AUTHENTICATE
- 23 OR ADOPT A RECORD, AN INDIVIDUAL DOES EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 24 (i) EXECUTES OR ADOPTS A TANGIBLE SYMBOL.
- 25 (ii) ATTACHES TO OR LOGICALLY ASSOCIATES WITH THE RECORD AN
- 26 ELECTRONIC SYMBOL, SOUND, OR PROCESS.
