## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## SENATE BILL NO. 685

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 40114 (MCL 324.40114), as amended by 2010 PA 87.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 40114. (1) The department may issue a permit to a person
- 2 AN INDIVIDUAL who is unable to walk because the person\_INDIVIDUAL
- 3 is a paraplegic or an amputee or because of a disease or injury
- 4 that has rendered the person-INDIVIDUAL permanently disabled. A
- 5 permit issued under this subsection authorizes the person
- 6 INDIVIDUAL to take game during the open season for that game,
- 7 including deer of either sex, from or upon a standing vehicle if
- 8 that person INDIVIDUAL holds a license to take that game issued
- 9 pursuant to UNDER part 435 and complies with all other laws and

- 1 rules for the taking of game.
- 2 (2) The department may issue a permit to a person AN
- 3 INDIVIDUAL who is permanently disabled, who has full use of only 1
- 4 arm, and who upon investigation is unable to hold, aim, and shoot a
- 5 bow. A permit issued under this subsection authorizes the person
- 6 INDIVIDUAL to take game during the open season for that game with a
- 7 bow that has been modified so that the bow may be held, aimed, and
- 8 shot with 1 arm, if that person INDIVIDUAL holds a license to take
- 9 that game issued pursuant to UNDER part 435 and complies with all
- 10 other laws and rules for the taking of game.
- 11 (3) The commission may issue an order under section 40113a
- 12 regulating the taking of game with a modified bow that may be shot
- 13 with 1 arm. Subsection (2) does not apply on or after the effective
- 14 date of such an order.
- 15 (4) In addition, the department may issue permits authorizing
- 16 1 or more of the following:
- 17 (a) The taking or possession of animals for the purpose of
- 18 rehabilitating animals.
- 19 (b) The taking of animals to prevent or control damage and
- 20 nuisance caused by the animals. A PERMITTEE UNDER A DEER DAMAGE
- 21 SHOOTING PERMIT MAY DESIGNATE NOT MORE THAN 15 AUTHORIZED SHOOTERS
- 22 TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE PERMIT UNLESS THE DEPARTMENT
- 23 AUTHORIZES OTHERWISE.
- 24 (c) The collection, transportation, possession, or disposition
- 25 of animals and parts of animals for scientific purposes.
- 26 (d) The public exhibition of animals.
- (e) Taxidermy.

- 1 (f) The disposition of accidentally or unlawfully taken or
- 2 injured animals or animals that are unlawfully possessed.
- ${\bf 3}$  (g) The taking of game with a crossbow by a person  ${\bf AN}$
- 4 INDIVIDUAL who is permanently or temporarily disabled.
- 5 (h) The taking or possession of raptors for the purposes of
- 6 falconry.
- 7 (5) A permit issued under this section may be suspended,
- 8 revoked, annulled, withdrawn, recalled, canceled, or amended
- 9 pursuant to the administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306,
- 10 MCL 24.201 to 24.328. If the holder of a permit is convicted of
- 11 violating the permit or this section, his or her permit or license
- 12 may be revoked and any animal and the parts of any animal in his or
- 13 her possession shall be disposed of in a manner approved by the
- 14 department.
- 15 (6) Fees received for permits and licenses issued under this
- 16 section shall be forwarded by the department to the state treasurer
- 17 to be credited to the game and fish protection account of the
- 18 Michigan conservation and recreation legacy fund provided for in
- **19** section 2010.
