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- 2 Sec. 1201. (1) It is the intent of the legislature to provide
- 3 appropriations for the fiscal year ending on September 30, 2014 for
- 4 the line items listed in part 1. The fiscal year 2013-2014
- 5 appropriations are anticipated to be the same as those for fiscal
- 6 year 2012-2013, except that the line items will be adjusted for
- 7 changes in caseload and related costs, federal fund match rates,
- 8 economic factors, and available revenue.

- 10 hired during fiscal year 2012-2013 shall be used to reduce crime
