## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4307

A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled "Michigan occupational safety and health act," by amending section 4 (MCL 408.1004).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) "Agricultural operations" means the work activity
- 2 designated in major groups 01 and 02 of the standard industrial
- 3 classification manual, United States bureau of the budget, 1972
- 4 edition THE NORTH AMERICAN INDUSTRY CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM,
- 5 SUBSECTORS 111, 112, AND 115, EXCLUDING SUBSECTOR 1153, UNITED
- 6 STATES CENSUS BUREAU, 2007 EDITION, AND INCLUDES WORK ACTIVITY
- 7 ASSOCIATED WITH CULTIVATED CHRISTMAS TREES. Agricultural operations
- 8 include any practices performed by a farmer or on a farm as an
- 9 incident to or in conjunction with farming operations including
- 10 preparation for market delivery to storage or market or to carriers

- 1 for transportation to market.
- 2 (2) "Authorized employee representative" or "representative of
- 3 employee" means a person designated by a labor organization
- 4 certified by the national labor relations board or employment
- 5 relations commission as defined in section 2(c) of Act No. 176 of
- 6 the Public Acts of 1939, as amended, being section 423.2 of the
- 7 Michigan Compiled Laws CREATED IN SECTION 3 OF 1939 PA 176, MCL
- 8 423.3, as the bargaining representative for the affected employees.
- 9 In the absence of certification, it shall be a person designated by
- 10 the organization having a collective bargaining relationship with
- 11 the employer and designated as having a collective bargaining
- 12 relationship with the employer by the affected employees. If a
- 13 labor organization has not been certified, or if no organization
- 14 has a collective bargaining relationship with the employer,
- 15 "authorized employee representative" or "representative of
- 16 employee" means a person designated by the affected employees to
- 17 represent them for the purpose of proceedings under this act.
- 18 (3) "Board" means the board of health and safety compliance
- 19 and appeals created in section 46.
- 20 (4) "Construction operations" means the work activity
- 21 designated in major groups 15, 16, and 17 of the standard
- 22 industrial classification manual, United States bureau of the
- 23 budget, 1972 edition.
- 24 (5) "Department attorney" means the attorney general or the
- 25 authorized representative of the attorney general.
- 26 (6) "Domestic employment" means that employment involving an
- 27 employee specifically employed by a householder to engage in work

- 1 or an activity relating to the operation of a household and its
- 2 surroundings, whether or not the employee resides in the household.
- 3 (7) "Mines", except as provided in subdivision (d), means all
- 4 of the following:
- 5 (a) An area of land from which minerals are extracted in
- 6 nonliquid form, or if in liquid form, are extracted with workers
- 7 underground.
- 8 (b) Private ways and roads appurtenant to an area of land
- 9 described in subdivision (a).
- 10 (c) Lands, excavations, underground passageways, shafts,
- 11 slopes, tunnels and workings, structures, facilities, equipment,
- 12 machines, tools, or other property, including impoundments,
- 13 retention dams, and tailings ponds, on the surface or underground,
- 14 used in, or to be used in, or resulting from, the work of
- 15 extracting minerals from their natural deposits in nonliquid form,
- 16 or if in liquid form, with workers underground, or used in, or to
- 17 be used in, the milling of minerals, or the work of preparing coal
- 18 or other minerals, and includes custom coal preparation facilities.
- 19 (d) This subsection does not include industrial borrow pits,
- 20 or sand, gravel, or crushed and dimension stone quarrying
- 21 operations, or surface construction operations.
