SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4387

A bill to amend 1975 PA 238, entitled "Child protection law,"

by amending section 7b (MCL 722.627b), as added by 1997 PA 167.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 7b. (1) By January 1, 1999, each EACH county may have in
- 2 place a standing child fatality review team. Two or more counties
- 3 may appoint a single child fatality review team for those counties.
- 4 The membership of a child fatality review team shall consist of at
- 5 least all of the following:
- 6 (a) A county medical examiner or deputy county medical
- 7 examiner appointed under 1963 1953 PA 181, MCL 52.201 to 52.216.
- 8 (b) A representative of a local law enforcement agency.
- 9 (c) A representative of the department.
- 10 (d) The county prosecuting attorney or a designated assistant

- 1 county prosecutor.
- 2 (e) A representative of the department of community health or
- 3 a local health department.
- 4 (F) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LOCAL COURT.
- 5 (2) A child fatality review team established under subsection
- 6 (1) shall review each child fatality occurring in the county or
- 7 counties that established the child fatality review team.
- 8 (3) The department shall make available to each child fatality
- 9 review team established under subsection (1) professional,
- 10 interagency training and orientation on the review of child
- 11 fatalities. The department shall make available, as necessary,
- 12 training on specific types of child fatalities, investigation
- 13 techniques, and prevention initiatives.
- 14 (4) By January 1, 1998, the THE department shall establish a
- 15 multiagency, multidisciplinary advisory committee to identify and
- 16 make recommendations on policy and statutory changes pertaining to
- 17 child fatalities and to guide statewide prevention, education, and
- 18 training efforts.
- 19 (5) The advisory committee created under subsection (4)
- 20 consists of the following:
- 21 (a) Two representatives of the family independence agency
- 22 DEPARTMENT.
- 23 (b) Two representatives of the department of community health.
- 24 (c) One county medical examiner.
- (d) One representative of law enforcement.
- (e) One county prosecuting attorney.
- 27 (f) The children's ombudsman or his or her designee.

- 2 (6) THE CITIZEN REVIEW PANEL SHALL REVIEW EACH CHILD FATALITY
- 3 THAT INVOLVES ALLEGATIONS OF CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT FOR EACH CHILD
- 4 WHO, AT THE TIME OF DEATH OR WITHIN THE 12 MONTHS PRECEDING THE
- 5 DEATH, WAS UNDER THE COURT'S JURISDICTION UNDER SECTION 2(B) OF
- 6 CHAPTER XIIA OF THE PROBATE CODE OF 1939, 1939 PA 288, MCL 712A.2.
- 7 (7) (6) Using BEGINNING DECEMBER 31, 2012, AND USING the
- 8 annual compilation of child fatalities reported by the state
- 9 registrar under part 28 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 10 333.2801 to 333.2899, and data received from the child fatality
- 11 review teams established under subsection (1) AND THE CITIZEN
- 12 REVIEW PANEL UNDER SUBSECTION (6), the advisory committee
- 13 established under subsection (4) shall publish AUTHOR an annual
- 14 report on child fatalities REVIEWED DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR
- 15 YEAR. The advisory committee shall include in the report, at a
- 16 minimum, all of the following:
- 17 (a) The total number of child fatalities and the type or cause
- 18 of each child fatality.
- 19 (b) The number of child fatalities that occurred while the
- 20 child was in foster care.
- 21 (c) The number of cases where the child's death occurred
- 22 within 5 years after family preservation or family reunification.
- 23 (d) Trends in child fatalities.
- 24 (8) (7) The advisory committee established under subsection
- 25 (4) shall break down the information required under subsection (6)
- 26 (7) by county or by groups of counties as described in subsection
- 27 (1). The information contained in the report is public information.

- 1 The advisory committee shall not include identifying information of
- 2 persons named in the report. The advisory committee SHALL TRANSMIT
- 3 THE FINAL REPORT UNDER SUBSECTION (7) TO THE DEPARTMENT BY DECEMBER
- 4 31 OF EACH YEAR. NOT LESS THAN 30 DAYS AND NOT MORE THAN 60 DAYS
- 5 AFTER TRANSMITTING THE REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT, THE DEPARTMENT
- 6 shall ENSURE PUBLICATION OF THE REPORT AND transmit a copy of the
- 7 report required under subsection (6) to the governor and to the
- 8 standing committees of the legislature with jurisdiction over
- 9 matters pertaining to child protection.
- 10 (9) (8) Information obtained by a child fatality review team
- 11 established under subsection (1) is confidential and may be
- 12 disclosed by the child fatality review team only to the department,
- 13 the children's ombudsman, the county prosecutor's office, local law
- 14 enforcement, or another child fatality review team. The information
- 15 is not subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL

- 17 (10) (9) An individual who is a member of a child fatality
- 18 review team established under subsection (1) or of the advisory
- 19 committee established under subsection (4) is a member of a board,
- 20 council, commission, or statutorily created task force of a
- 21 governmental agency for the purposes of section 7 of 1964 PA 170,
- 22 MCL 691.1407.
