SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5821

A bill to amend 2002 PA 733, entitled "State plumbing act," by amending sections 31 and 35 (MCL 338.3541 and 338.3545), as

amended by 2008 PA 370.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 31. (1) A license or apprentice registration issued under this act must be renewed not more than 60 days after the renewal date. It is the responsibility of a licensee or registrant to renew a license or registration. The department shall send a renewal application to the last known address of a licensee or registrant on file with the department. Every holder of a license or registration issued under this act shall promptly notify the department of a change in his or her business or

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residence address. The failure of a licensee or registrant to
 notify the department of a change of address does not extend the
 expiration date of a license or registration. The department may
 issue licenses for up to 3 years in duration.

5 (2) The annual fees for initial licensure, apprentice
6 plumber registration, or renewal of a license and registration
7 issued under this act are as follows:

25 (4) A person AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS requesting renewal of a

1 expired under subsection (3) is not subject to reexamination for 2 the license but is required to pay the reinstatement fee and the 3 annual renewal fee for each year THE LICENSE WAS not renewed. A 4 person AN INDIVIDUAL who fails to renew a license for more than 3 5 consecutive years is required to meet the experience and other 6 requirements and take an examination for the class of license 7 requested.

17 (6) The department shall issue an initial master plumber and OR plumbing contractor license for a period of up to 3 years. The 18 19 A master plumber and OR plumbing contractor licenses are LICENSE IS renewable for periods of 3 years. For a person IF AN 20 **INDIVIDUAL IS** applying for initial or reinstatement license at a 21 time other than between April 30 and June 30 of the year in which 22 the department issues renewal licenses, the department shall 23 compute and charge the license fee on a yearly prorated basis 24 25 beginning the year of application until the last year of the 3-26 year license period.

9 (8) All A plumbing contractor and OR master plumber licenses
10 LICENSE THAT IS not renewed within 60 days of expiration may be
11 reinstated only upon application submitted BY APPLYING to the
12 board and payment of PAYING the renewal fee and, if paid after
13 September 30, 2012, 2015, an \$85.00 reinstatement fee, and
14 \$100.00 if paid on or before September 30, 2012.2015.

(9) Beginning July 23, 2004, the **THE** department shall issue 15 an initial or renewal license for a master plumber or a plumbing 16 17 contractor UNDER THIS ACT not later than 90 days after the 18 applicant files a completed application. Receipt THE DATE OF 19 FILING of the application is considered the date the application 20 is received by any agency or department of the THIS state. of 21 Michigan. If the application is considered incomplete by the department, the department shall notify the applicant in writing, 22 23 or make the information electronically available TO THE 24 APPLICANT, within 30 days after receipt THE DATE OF FILING of the 25 incomplete application, describing the deficiency and requesting 26 the additional information. The 90-day period is tolled upon FROM

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THE DATE OF notification by the department of a deficiency until
 the date the requested information is received by the department.
 The determination of the completeness of an application does not
 operate as an approval of the application for the license and
 does not confer eligibility of an applicant determined otherwise
 ineligible for issuance of a license.

7 (10) If the department fails to issue or deny a license within the time required by UNDER this section, the department 8 shall return the license fee and shall reduce the license fee for 9 10 the applicant's next renewal application, if any, by 15%. The failure to issue a license within the time required under this 11 12 section does not allow the department to otherwise delay the 13 processing of the application, and THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PLACE that application, upon completion, shall be placed WHEN 14 15 COMPLETED, in sequence with other completed applications received 16 at that same time. The department shall not discriminate against 17 an applicant in the processing of the application based upon ON the fact that the license fee was refunded or discounted under 18 19 this subsection.

(11) Beginning October 1, 2005, the THE director shall submit a report by December 1 of each year to the standing committees and appropriations subcommittees of the senate and house of representatives concerned with occupational issues. The director shall include all of the following information in the report concerning the preceding fiscal year:

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[(12) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL WAIVE ANY FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION OR SECTION 35 IF THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING THE FEE MEETS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

(A) IF THE PERSON IS AN INDIVIDUAL, HE OR SHE IS, AND PROVIDES PROOF SATISFACTORY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT HE OR SHE IS, AN HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERAN OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

(B) IF THE PERSON IS A NONPROFIT CORPORATION ORGANIZED ON A MEMBERSHIP OR DIRECTORSHIP BASIS, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OR DIRECTORS, AS APPLICABLE, ARE, AND THE PERSON PROVIDES PROOF SATISFACTORY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OR DIRECTORS ARE, HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERANS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.

(C) IF THE PERSON IS NOT AN INDIVIDUAL OR A NONPROFIT CORPORATION DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (B), A MAJORITY OF THE SHARES OR OTHER OWNERSHIP INTERESTS OF THE PERSON ARE, AND THE PERSON PROVIDES PROOF SATISFACTORY TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT THOSE INTERESTS ARE, HELD BY 1 OR MORE HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERANS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES.
