

HOUSE BILL No. 5917

September 19, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Graves and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled "Michigan occupational safety and health act," by amending section 19 (MCL 408.1019), as amended by 1991 PA 105; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 19. ~~(1) The construction safety standards commission~~ **THE**
2 **DIRECTOR** may promulgate construction safety standards in accordance
3 with this act and based upon, but not limited to, generally
4 accepted nationwide engineering standards and practices designed to
5 prevent accidents and to protect the life and safety of employees
6 engaged in construction operations. If practicable, the standards
7 promulgated shall be expressed in terms of objective criteria and
8 of the performance desired.

9 ~~(2) Until April 1, 1992, adoption of a standard shall be by a~~
