

HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 959

A bill to make appropriations for the department of military and veterans affairs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; to provide for certain powers and duties of the department of military and veterans affairs, other state agencies, and local units of government related to the appropriations; and to provide for the preparation of certain reports related to the appropriations.

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PART 1

LINE-ITEM APPROPRIATIONS
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013

Sec. 101. Subject to the conditions set forth in this act, the amounts listed in this part for the department of military and

veterans affairs are appropriated for the fiscal year ending
September 30, 2013 from the funds indicated in this part. The
following is a summary of the appropriations in this part:

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
constitution of 1963, total state spending from state resources
under part 1 for fiscal year 2012-2013 is \$100.00 and state
spending from state resources to be paid to local units of
government for fiscal year 2012-2013 is \$0.

Sec. 202. The appropriations authorized under this act are
subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
to 18.1594.

PART 2A

PROVISIONS CONCERNING ANTICIPATED APPROPRIATIONS

FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014

GENERAL SECTIONS

Sec. 1201. (1) It is the intent of the legislature to provide

1 appropriations for the fiscal year ending on September 30, 2014 for
2 the line items listed in part 1. The fiscal year 2013-2014
3 appropriations are anticipated to be the same as those for fiscal
4 year 2012-2013, except that the line items will be adjusted for
5 changes in caseload and related costs, federal fund match rates,
6 economic factors, and available revenue.

7 (2) The department shall identify and upgrade 15 red armories
8 to yellow or green facilities as determined by the measure
9 established in section 302(4).
