## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1505A. IF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 2 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY PROVIDES INSTRUCTION TO PUPILS
- 3 ON CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE PURSUANT TO THE POLICY ADOPTED UNDER SECTION
- 1505, BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- (A) A PUPIL SHALL NOT BE PROVIDED WITH THE INSTRUCTION UNLESS
- THE PUPIL'S PARENT OR GUARDIAN IS NOTIFIED IN ADVANCE OF THE
- INSTRUCTION AND THE CONTENT OF THE INSTRUCTION, IS GIVEN A PRIOR
- OPPORTUNITY TO REVIEW THE MATERIALS TO BE USED IN THE INSTRUCTION,
- 9 AND IS NOTIFIED IN ADVANCE OF HIS OR HER RIGHT TO HAVE THE PUPIL
- 10 EXCUSED FROM THE INSTRUCTION.

- 1 (B) UPON THE WRITTEN REQUEST OF A PUPIL'S PARENT OR LEGAL
- 2 GUARDIAN, A PUPIL SHALL BE EXCUSED FROM THE INSTRUCTION WITHOUT
- 3 PENALTY OR LOSS OF ACADEMIC CREDIT.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
