## HOUSE BILL No. 4670

## May 24, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Foster, Huuki, Pettalia, Wayne Schmidt, Lindberg and McBroom and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2009 PA 99, and by adding section 811r.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 811e. (1) Beginning January 1, 2007, the THE secretary of
 state may develop a fund-raising plate as provided in this section.

3 (2) A start-up fee of \$15,000.00 shall be paid for any new 4 fund-raising plate authorized under this section. The fee shall be 5 deposited in the transportation administration collection fund 6 through October 1, 2011 to be used for the cost of creating, 7 producing, and issuing fund-raising plates. If the fee described in 8 this subsection is not paid within 18 months of AFTER the effective 9 date of the public act that authorizes the development and issuance 10 of a fund-raising plate, then the related fund-raising plate shall

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not be created, produced, or issued. A start-up fee paid under this
 subsection is nonrefundable.

3 (3) Not less than 3 years after the secretary of state first 4 issues 1 of the fund-raising plates as described in subsection (1) and upon payment of \$2,000.00, the Michigan university or other 5 person sponsoring that fund-raising plate may redesign it as 6 approved by the secretary of state. The payment required under this 7 subsection shall be deposited in the transportation administration 8 9 collection fund through October 1, 2011 to be used for the cost of 10 creating, producing, and issuing fund-raising plates. A payment 11 under this subsection is nonrefundable.

12 (4) The secretary of state may develop 1 or more limited term
13 registration plates to recognize a Michigan university or an
14 accomplishment or occasion of a Michigan university.

15 (5) The secretary of state may , at any 1 time, develop not 16 more than 8 different state sponsored fund-raising registration 17 plates as described in this section, and matching state-sponsored 18 collector plates as described in section 811g.

19 (6) The secretary of state shall not develop or issue a fund20 raising plate unless a public act authorizing the fund-raising
21 plate, at a minimum, does all of the following:

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(a) Identifies the purpose of the fund-raising plate.

(b) Creates a nonprofit fund or designates an existing
nonprofit fund to receive the money raised through the sale of
fund-raising plates and matching collector plates.

26 (c) If a fund is created, names the person or entity27 responsible for administering the fund.

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SEC. 811R. (1) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER
 SECTION 811E AND ISSUE UNDER SECTION 811F A FUND-RAISING PLATE FOR
 THE MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION. THE SECRETARY OF
 STATE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES
 ASSOCIATION SHALL DESIGN THE FUND-RAISING PLATES AUTHORIZED IN THIS
 SECTION.

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7 (2) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
8 THIS ACT MAY APPLY, ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE,
9 FOR A MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION FUND-RAISING PLATE
10 AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION 811F INSTEAD OF A STANDARD REGISTRATION
11 PLATE.

(3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
FROM THE SALE OF MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION FUNDRAISING PLATES TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE
DONATION MONEY TO THE MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION
FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (4).

17 (4) THE MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION FUND IS
18 CREATED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE
19 MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND.
20 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE
21 STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM
22 FUND INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR
23 SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

(5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND ON A
QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION.
BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1, 2013, THE MICHIGAN SNOWSPORTS
INDUSTRIES ASSOCIATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A

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SUMMARY OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY
 RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.
