

HOUSE BILL No. 5768

June 14, 2012, Introduced by Reps. McMillin, MacMaster, Irwin, Ananich, Foster and McBroom and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to prohibit any agency of this state, any political subdivision of this state, any employee of any agency of this state or any political subdivision of this state, or any member of the Michigan national guard from assisting an agency of the armed forces of the United States in the investigation, prosecution, or detainment of any citizen of the United States under certain circumstances.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) Subject to subsection (2), notwithstanding any
2 provision of law to the contrary, no agency of this state, no
3 political subdivision of this state, no employee of an agency of
4 this state or a political subdivision of this state acting in his
5 or her official capacity, and no member of the Michigan national

1 guard on official state duty shall aid an agency of the armed
2 forces of the United States in any investigation, prosecution, or
3 detention of any person pursuant to 50 USC 1541, as provided by the
4 federal national defense authorization act for fiscal year 2012,
5 Public Law 112-81, if such aid would place that state agency,
6 political subdivision, employee, or member of the Michigan national
7 guard in violation of the United States constitution, the state
8 constitution of 1963, or any law of this state.

9 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to participation by state or
10 local law enforcement or the Michigan national guard in a joint
11 task force, partnership, or other similar cooperative agreement
12 with federal law enforcement if that joint task force, partnership,
13 or similar cooperative agreement is not for the purpose of
14 investigating, prosecuting, or detaining any citizen of the United
15 States pursuant to 50 USC 1541.
