## **HOUSE BILL No. 5966**

October 17, 2012, Introduced by Reps. McMillin, Poleski, Clemente and Howze and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1993 PA 23, entitled "Michigan limited liability company act,"

by amending section 904 (MCL 450.4904), as amended by 2010 PA 126.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 904. (1) Except as provided in this section or otherwise prohibited, a professional limited liability company may render 1 or more professional services, and each member and manager must be a licensed person in 1 or more of the professional services rendered by the company.
  - (2) Except as provided in subsection (3) or (4), if a professional limited liability company renders a professional service that is included within the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211, then all members and managers of
