

# SENATE BILL No. 304

March 24, 2011, Introduced by Senator JONES and referred to the Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing.

A bill to establish the terms on which health benefits may be provided to legislators.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the  
2 "legislative health benefits act".

3           Sec. 2. As used in this act:

4           (a) "Health coverage" means hospital, medical-surgical,  
5 dental, optical, and hearing insurance benefits.

6           (b) "Legislator" means a person duly elected and serving in  
7 the house of representatives or senate of this state.

8           Sec. 3. This state shall pay not more than 80% of the costs of  
9 any health coverage it provides to a legislator during the  
10 legislator's term of office.

1 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect January 1, 2013.
