

SENATE BILL No. 848

November 10, 2011, Introduced by Senators BIEDA, BRANDENBURG, JONES, HANSEN, PROOS and WARREN and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 84 (MCL 750.84).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 ~~Sec. 84. Assault with intent to do great bodily harm less than~~
2 ~~murder.~~ ~~Any~~ **A** person who ~~shall assault~~ **ASSAULTS** another with intent
3 to do great bodily harm, less than the crime of murder, ~~shall be~~

5 **OR SUFFOCATION, IS** guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in
6 the state prison not more than 10 years ~~—~~ or by fine of not more
7 than ~~5,000 dollars.~~ **\$5,000.00, OR BOTH. AS USED IN THIS SECTION,**
8 **"STRANGULATION OR SUFFOCATION" MEANS INTENTIONALLY IMPEDING NORMAL**
9 **BREATHING OR CIRCULATION OF THE BLOOD BY APPLYING PRESSURE ON THE**
10 **THROAT OR NECK OR BY BLOCKING THE NOSE OR MOUTH OF ANOTHER PERSON.**
