A bill to amend 2000 PA 92, entitled

"Food law of 2000,"

by amending section 4102 (MCL 289.4102), as added by 2010 PA 112.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4102. (1) A cottage food operation is exempt from the

2 licensing and evaluation provisions of this act. This exemption

3 does not include an exemption from the adulteration and other

standards imposed in this section or under this act, or both, and

does not limit the ability of the department to take appropriate

enforcement action for applicable violations as described in

section 5101. This subsection does not require a cottage food

operation to meet the standards contained in 21 CFR 110 or the 2005

9 federal food code., or both.

- 1 (2) Cottage food products shall be prepackaged and properly
- 2 labeled prior to sale.
- 3 (3) At a minimum, a cottage food operation shall place on the
- 4 label of any food it produces or packages the following
- 5 information:
- 6 (a) The name and address of the business of the cottage food

- 8 (b) The name of the cottage food product.
- 9 (c) The ingredients of the cottage food product, in descending
- 10 order of predominance by weight.
- 11 (d) The net weight or net volume of the cottage food product.
- 12 (e) Allergen labeling as specified by federal labeling
- 13 requirements.
- 14 (f) If any nutritional claim is made, appropriate labeling as
- 15 specified by federal labeling requirements.
- 16 (g) The following statement printed in at least the equivalent
- 17 of 11-point font size in a color that provides a clear contrast to
- 18 the background: "Made in a home kitchen that has not been inspected
- 19 by the Michigan department of agriculture."
- 20 (4) Cottage food products may be sold directly from the
- 21 cottage food operation to the consumer only, and not by internet or
- 22 mail order. Sales by consignment or at wholesale are prohibited.
- 23 (5) The gross sales of cottage food products shall not exceed
- 24 \$15,000.00 \$30,000.00 annually. The determination of the \$15,000.00
- 25 \$30,000.00 annual gross sales shall be computed on the basis of the
- 26 amount of gross sales within or at a particular domestic residence

- 3 (6) Cottage food products shall be stored only in the primary
- 4 domestic residence.
- 5 (7) An exemption under this section does not affect the
- 6 application of any other state or federal laws or any applicable
- 7 ordinances enacted by any local unit of government.
