## **HOUSE BILL No. 4132**

January 25, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Heise, Muxlow, Somerville and Forlini and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled

"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"

by amending section 1301 (MCL 324.1301), as amended by 2009 PA 120.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1301. As used in this part:
  - (a) "Application period" means the period beginning when an application for a permit is received by the state and ending when the application is considered to be administratively complete under section 1305 and any applicable fee has been paid.
    - (b) "Department" means the department, agency, or officer authorized by this act to approve or deny an application for a particular permit.
      - (c) "Director" means the director of the state department

- 25 (iv) Sixty days, for a permit under section 30104 for a minor
- 26 project as established by rule under section 30105(7) or for a
- 27 permit under section 32312.

- 1 (v) Sixty days or, if a hearing is held, 90 days for a permit
- 2 under section 35304.
- 3 (vi) Sixty days or, if a hearing is held, 120 days for a permit
- 4 under section 30104, other than a permit for a minor project as
- 5 established by rule under section 30105(7), or for a permit under
- 6 section 31509.
- 7 (vii) Ninety days for a permit under section 11512, a revision
- 8 of a surface coal mining and reclamation permit during the term of
- 9 the permit under section 63525, or a permit under section 72108.
