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## **HOUSE BILL No. 4420**

March 15, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Walsh, Goike, Rutledge, Wayne Schmidt, Heise, Cotter, Potvin, Foster, Zorn, Horn and Shirkey and referred to the Committee on Oversight, Reform, and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 300, entitled
"The public school employees retirement act of 1979,"
by amending sections 6 and 7 (MCL 38.1306 and 38.1307), as amended
by 1995 PA 272.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 6. (1) "Original member" means a member employed in
   Michigan public schools before July 1, 1945.
- 3 (2) "Out of system public education service" means service
   4 performed in public education meeting 1 or more of the following
   5 requirements:
  - (a) Performed in other states in the United States or its territorial possessions.
  - (b) Performed at the university of Michigan, Michigan state university, Wayne state university, Grand Valley state university, Oakland university, or Saginaw Valley university.

- 1 (c) Service purchased before January 31, 1991 and performed in
- 2 a juvenile training school operated by a county in this state.
- 3 (d) Service purchased before January 31, 1991 and performed in
- 4 a community mental health service program operated under former Act
- 5 No. 54 of the Public Acts of 1963 PA 54 for the severely
- 6 mentally retarded in day care programs, day training programs, or
- 7 day care training programs that were transferred to an intermediate
- 8 school district by direction of the department of education.
- 9 (e) Service purchased before January 31, 1991 and performed as
- 10 an elementary or secondary teacher at a United States armed forces
- 11 military base in the United States or a foreign country.
- 12 (f) Service purchased before January 31, 1991 and performed as
- 13 a teacher or administrator of American nationals in overseas public
- 14 elementary or secondary schools operated by the United States
- 15 department of defense.
- 16 (g) Performed by a person who first becomes employed by an
- 17 institution of higher education described in section 4, 5, or 6 of
- 18 article VIII of the state constitution of 1963 on or after January
- **19** 1, 1996.
- 20 (H) PERFORMED BY A PERSON WHO FIRST BECOMES EMPLOYED BY A
- 21 QUALIFIED TAX SUPPORTED COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE ON OR AFTER
- 22 JANUARY 1, 2012.
- 23 (3) "Prior service" means service performed before July 1,
- **24** 1945.
- 25 (4) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, "public
- 26 school academy" means a public school academy established under
- 27 part 6a or 6b of the REVISED school code, of 1976, Act No. 451 of

- 1 the Public Acts of 1976, being sections 380.501 to 380.507 and
- 2 380.511 to 380.518 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1976 PA 451, MCL
- 3 380.501 TO 380.507. Public school academy does not include any of
- 4 the following:
- 5 (a) A public school academy operated by a state public
- 6 university that is not subject to the optional retirement act of
- 7 1967, Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of 1967, being sections 38.381
- 8 to 38.388 of the Michigan Compiled Laws 1967 PA 156, MCL 38.381 TO

- 10 (b) A public school academy corporation formed by a state
- 11 public university that is not subject to Act No. 156 of the Public
- 12 Acts of 1967 THE OPTIONAL RETIREMENT ACT OF 1967, 1967 PA 156, MCL
- 13 38.381 TO 38.388.
- 14 (5) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, "public
- 15 school employee" means an employee of a public local school
- 16 district, intermediate school district, public school academy, tax
- 17 supported community or junior college, eastern Michigan university,
- 18 central Michigan university, northern Michigan university, western
- 19 Michigan university, Ferris state university, Michigan
- 20 technological university, Lake Superior state university, or
- 21 district library as defined in section 69g if the conditions in
- 22 section 69g(1) are met for that employee. Service at Michigan
- 23 technological university shall be creditable only if the amount of
- 24 the accumulated contributions in the state employees' retirement
- 25 system created by the state employees' retirement act, Act No. 240
- of the Public Acts of 1943, being sections 38.1 to 38.48 of the
- 27 Michigan Compiled Laws 1943 PA 240, MCL 38.1 TO 38.69, for service

- 1 is paid to the retirement system. Service at Ferris state
- 2 university shall be creditable as prior service or membership
- 3 service only if the employee was employed at Ferris state
- 4 university on a full-time basis for 2 or more years after May 17,
- 5 1949. Until January 1, 1988, public school employee also includes a
- 6 person holding a Michigan teacher certificate and serving as an
- 7 employee of the Michigan high school athletic association, other
- 8 than a person whose effective date of employment with the Michigan

- 10 Public school employee includes a public school employee on an
- 11 approved leave of absence. Public school employee does not include

- 14 DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON WHO FIRST BECOMES EMPLOYED BY A QUALIFIED
- 15 TAX SUPPORTED COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1,
- 16 2012.
- 17 (6) "QUALIFIED TAX SUPPORTED COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE"
- 18 MEANS A TAX SUPPORTED COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE THAT HAS
- 19 SUBMITTED AN APPROPRIATE RESOLUTION TO WITHDRAW FROM THE RETIREMENT
- 20 SYSTEM TO THE RETIREMENT BOARD NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 1, 2011.
- 21 Sec. 7. (1) "Refund beneficiary" means 1 or more persons whom
- 22 the member or former member nominates in writing and files with the
- 23 retirement system for the purpose of being paid accumulated
- 24 contributions in the event of the death of the member or former
- 25 member. If a valid nomination is not on file, the retirement board
- 26 shall pay the accumulated contributions to the legal representative
- 27 of the deceased member or deceased former member, if any, or to the

- 1 estate of the deceased member or deceased former member.
- 2 (2) "Regular interest" means interest at 1 or more rates per
- 3 annum determined by the retirement board and compounded annually.
- 4 (3) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
- 5 "reporting unit" means a public school district, intermediate
- 6 school district, public school academy, tax supported community or
- 7 junior college, or university, or an agency having employees on its
- 8 payroll who are members of this retirement system. The reporting
- 9 unit shall be the employer for purposes of this act. On and after
- 10 January 1, 1996, reporting unit does not include a university,
- 11 except to the extent that university has employees on its payroll
- 12 who are members of this retirement system. ON AND AFTER JANUARY 1,
- 13 2012, REPORTING UNIT DOES NOT INCLUDE A QUALIFIED TAX SUPPORTED
- 14 COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT THAT THE COMMUNITY
- 15 OR JUNIOR COLLEGE HAS EMPLOYEES ON ITS PAYROLL WHO ARE MEMBERS OF
- 16 THE SYSTEM.
- 17 (4) "Retirant" means a member who retires with a retirement
- 18 allowance payable from reserves of the retirement system.
- 19 (5) "Retirement allowance" means a payment for life or a
- 20 temporary period provided for in this act to which a retirant,
- 21 retirement allowance beneficiary, or refund beneficiary is
- 22 entitled.
- 23 (6) "Retirement allowance beneficiary" means a person who is
- 24 being paid or has entitlement to the payment of a retirement
- 25 allowance in the event of the death of a member, deferred member,
- 26 or retirant.
- 27 (7) "Retirement board" means the board provided to administer

- 1 this retirement system.
- 2 (8) "Retirement system" means the Michigan public school
- 3 employees' retirement system provided for in this act.
