HOUSE BILL No. 4546

April 13, 2011, Introduced by Rep. LeBlanc and referred to the Committee on Redistricting and Elections.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 6 (MCL 380.6), as amended by 2009 PA 205.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) "School district" or "local school district" means
- 2 a general powers school district organized under this act,
- 3 regardless of previous classification, or a school district of the
- 4 first class.
 - (2) "School district filing official" means the school district election coordinator as defined in section 4 of the Michigan election law, MCL 168.4, or an authorized agent of the school district election coordinator.
 - (3) "School elector" means a person qualified as an elector under section 492 of the Michigan election law, MCL 168.492, and resident of the school district or intermediate school district on

- 17 (12) "Student with a disability" means that term as defined in
- 18 R 340.1702 of the Michigan administrative code.
- 19 (13) "Department" means the department of education created
- 20 and operating under sections 300 to 305 of the executive
- 21 organization act of 1965, 1965 PA 380, MCL 16.400 to 16.405.
- 22 (14) "State school aid" means allotments from the general
- 23 appropriating act for the purpose of aiding in the support of the
- 24 public schools of the state.
- 25 (15) "The state school aid act of 1979" means the state school
- 26 aid act of 1979, 1979 PA 94, MCL 388.1601 to 388.1772.
