## **HOUSE BILL No. 4565**

April 21, 2011, Introduced by Reps. Tyler, Lori, Huuki, Brown, Liss, Jacobsen, Heise, O'Brien, Pettalia, Foster, Knollenberg and Slavens and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 7212 (MCL 333.7212), as amended by 2010 PA 171.
