- 1 SEC. 696A. (1) AT LEAST 60 DAYS BEFORE THE GENERAL NOVEMBER
- 2 ELECTION IN EACH PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION YEAR, EACH CANDIDATE FOR
- 3 PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES WHO WANTS TO HAVE HIS OR HER NAME
- 4 PRINTED ON THE GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION BALLOT SHALL PROVIDE ALL
- 5 OF THE FOLLOWING TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE:
- 6 (A) AN AFFIDAVIT SIGNED BY THE CANDIDATE WHICH INCLUDES A
 - STATEMENT THAT THE CANDIDATE MEETS ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
 - PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 1 OF
- 9 ARTICLE II OF THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION.
 - (B) THE CANDIDATE'S ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE OR A CERTIFIED
