- 2 REPORTS AND PAID ANY LATE FILING FEES OR FINES REQUIRED OF THE
- 3 CANDIDATE OR A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE ORGANIZED TO SUPPORT THE
- 4 CANDIDATE'S ELECTION UNDER THE MICHIGAN CAMPAIGN FINANCE ACT, 1976
- 5 PA 388, MCL 169.201 TO 169.282, AND THOSE STATEMENTS, REPORTS, LATE
- 6 FILING FEES, OR FINES REMAIN UNFILED OR UNPAID FOR MORE THAN 12
- 7 MONTHS, THAT CANDIDATE IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO RUN FOR ANY PUBLIC OFFICE
- 8 IN THIS STATE UNTIL THOSE STATEMENTS, REPORTS, LATE FILING FEES, OR
