THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 218. (1) THE DIRECTOR SHALL ENSURE THAT THE ACTIVITIES OF
- 2 EACH STATE AGENCY ARE DIRECTED TOWARD ACHIEVING THE STRATEGY AND
- 3 GOALS DETERMINED BY THE MICHIGAN PROGRESS BOARD. THE DEPARTMENT
- 4 SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) MONITOR PROGRESS, IDENTIFY BARRIERS, AND GENERATE
 ALTERNATIVE APPROACHES FOR ATTAINING THE BENCHMARKS.
 - (B) ENSURE THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STATEWIDE SYSTEM OF
 PERFORMANCE MEASURES DESIGNED TO INCREASE THE EFFICIENCY AND
