3	SEC. 14001. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON
4	SHALL NOT SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, POSSESS FOR SALE, GIVE AWAY, USE,
5	OR PRESCRIBE ANY PRODUCT USED FOR THE TREATMENT OF LICE OR SCABIES
6	IN HUMAN BEINGS THAT CONTAINS THE PESTICIDE CHEMICAL LINDANE.
