Sec. 303a. This chapter does not apply to recreational card

  commission by a senior citizens club or a group of residents of a

  THE senior citizen housing facility OR A GROUP OF SENIOR CITIZENS

  that consists of at least 15 members—INDIVIDUALS who are 60 years

  of age or older under all of the following circumstances:
  - (a) The card playing is conducted solely for the amusement and recreation of the members and guests of the <del>club or group and is not conducted for fund-raising. The number of guests participating</del>
