A bill to amend 1974 PA 154, entitled "Michigan occupational safety and health act," (MCL 408.1001 to 408.1094) by adding section 13a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 13A. IF FEDERAL STANDARDS APPLY TO A WORKPLACE ACTIVITY,
- 2 A RULE SHALL NOT BE PROMULGATED OR ENFORCED UNDER THIS ACT THAT IS
- 3 STRICTER THAN THE APPLICABLE FEDERAL STANDARD UNLESS THERE IS
- 4 SPECIFIC STATUTORY AUTHORITY TO PROMULGATE OR ENFORCE MORE
- 5 STRINGENT STANDARDS.
