## **HOUSE BILL No. 5184**

November 29, 2011, Introduced by Rep. Lund and referred to the Committee on Redistricting and Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 42 (MCL 168.42), as amended by 1999 PA 216.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 42. (1) In the year in which presidential electors are to
- 2 be elected under section 43, each political party in this state
- 3 shall choose at its fall state convention a number of candidates
- 4 for electors of president and vice-president of the United States
- 5 equal to the number of senators and representatives in congress
- that this state is entitled to elect. ONE PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR
  - SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM EACH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT, AND 2
- PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS SHALL BE CHOSEN AT LARGE. The chairperson and
- 9 the secretary of the state central committee of each political
- 0 party shall, within 1 business day after the conclusion of the

- 1 state convention, forward by registered or certified mail a
- 2 certificate containing the names of the candidates for PRESIDENTIAL
- 3 electors to the secretary of state. The candidates for electors of
- 4 president and vice-president who shall be considered elected are
- 5 those whose names have been certified to the secretary of state by
- 6 that political party receiving the greatest number of votes for
- 7 those offices at the next November election.
- 8 (2) A CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR SHALL BE CONSIDERED
- 9 ELECTED FROM A CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT IF HIS OR HER NAME WAS
- 10 CERTIFIED TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE BY A POLITICAL PARTY AS
- 11 PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1) AND THAT POLITICAL PARTY RECEIVES THE
- 12 GREATEST NUMBER OF VOTES FOR PRESIDENT IN THAT CONGRESSIONAL
- 13 DISTRICT IN THE GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION.
- 14 (3) A CANDIDATE FOR PRESIDENTIAL ELECTOR SHALL BE CONSIDERED
- 15 ELECTED AT LARGE IF HIS OR HER NAME WAS CERTIFIED TO THE SECRETARY
- 16 OF STATE BY A POLITICAL PARTY AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (1) AND
- 17 THAT POLITICAL PARTY RECEIVES THE GREATEST NUMBER OF VOTES FOR
- 18 PRESIDENT IN THIS STATE IN THE GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION.
- 19 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 20 (A) PREPARE INFORMATIONAL MATERIAL FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND
- 21 FOR EACH COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, AND VILLAGE CLERK CONCERNING THE
- 22 REVISED ELECTORAL VOTING PROCESS AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (2) AND
- 23 (3).
- 24 (B) PREPARE AND SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR, SENATE
- 25 MAJORITY LEADER, AND SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES BY
- 26 SEPTEMBER 30, 2012, CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF THE REVISED
- 27 ELECTORAL VOTING PROCESS AND ITS IMPACT ON THIS STATE.
