

# HOUSE BILL No. 5272

January 24, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Pscholka, Tyler, Nesbitt and Lori and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies and for capital outlay for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the various state departments and agencies and capital outlay to supplement appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, from the following funds:

17 **PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS**

18 **GENERAL SECTIONS**

19 Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of  
 20 article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending  
 21 from state resources under part 1 for the fiscal year ending  
 22 September 30, 2012 is \$200.00 and state spending from state  
 23 resources to be paid to local units of government is \$200.00.

24 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized  
 25 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,

1 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are  
2 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101  
3 to 18.1594.

4       Sec. 204. Funds appropriated in part 1 shall not be used for  
5 the purchase of foreign goods or services, or both, if  
6 competitively priced and of comparable quality American goods or  
7 services, or both are available. Preference should be given to  
8 goods or services, or both, manufactured or provided by Michigan  
9 businesses, if they are competitively priced and of comparable  
10 quality. In addition, preference should be given to goods or  
11 services, or both, that are manufactured or provided by Michigan  
12 businesses owned and operated by veterans, if they are  
13 competitively priced and of comparable quality.

14 **CAPITAL OUTLAY PROCESS**

15       Sec. 301. Each capital outlay project authorized in this act  
16 or any previous capital outlay act shall comply with the procedures  
17 required by the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101  
18 to 18.1594.
