 - casting, machining, or other processes for working materials.

- 1 Sec. 2. The legislature finds all of the following:
- 2 (a) An asthma inhaler that is manufactured in this state
- 3 without the inclusion of parts, other than generic or insignificant
- 4 parts, imported from outside of this state and that remains within
- 5 this state has not entered into interstate commerce and is not
- 6 subject to congressional authority to regulate interstate commerce.
- 7 (b) Basic materials, such as unmachined and unshaped steel and
