## **HOUSE BILL No. 5455**

March 6, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Forlini and referred to the Committee on Local, Intergovernmental, and Regional Affairs.

A bill to amend 1996 PA 195, entitled "Police officer's and fire fighter's survivor tuition act," by amending section 2 (MCL 390.1242).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
  - (a) "Child" means an individual who is a natural or adopted child of a deceased Michigan police officer or deceased Michigan fire fighter and who was under the age of 21 at the time of the Michigan police officer's or Michigan fire fighter's death.
  - (b) "Department" means the department of state police.TREASURY.
    - (c) "Killed" means that the Michigan police officer's or

- 1 Michigan fire fighter's death is the direct and proximate result of
- 2 a traumatic injury incurred in the line of duty.
- 3 (d) "Line of duty" means an action that a Michigan police
- 4 officer or Michigan fire fighter is obligated or authorized to
- 5 perform by rule, regulation, condition of employment or service, or
- 6 law, including, but not limited to, a social, ceremonial, or
- 7 athletic function that the Michigan police officer or Michigan fire
- 8 fighter is assigned to or compensated for by the public agency he
- 9 or she serves.
- 10 (e) "Michigan police officer" means a sheriff or sheriff's
- 11 deputy of a sheriff's department in this state; village or township
- 12 marshal of a village or township in this state; officer of the

- 14 officer of the Michigan state police; or any other police officer
- 15 or law enforcement officer trained and certified pursuant to UNDER
- 16 the Michigan law enforcement officers training council act of 1965,
- 17 Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, being sections 28.601 to
- 18 28.616 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 19 STANDARDS ACT, 1965 PA 203, MCL 28.601 TO 28.616.
- (f) "Michigan fire fighter" means a member including volunteer
- 21 members and members paid on call of a fire department, or other
- 22 organization that provides fire suppression and other fire-related
- 23 services, of a city, township, village, or county who is
- 24 responsible for or is in a capacity that includes responsibility
- 25 for the extinguishment of fires. Michigan fire fighter does not
- 26 include a person whose job description, duties, or responsibilities
- 27 do not include direct involvement in fire suppression.

- 1 (g) "Occupational disease" means a disease that routinely
- 2 constitutes a special hazard in, or is commonly regarded as
- 3 concomitant of, the Michigan police officer's or Michigan fire

- 5 (h) "State institution of higher education" means a public
- 6 community or junior college established under section 7 of article
- 7 VIII of the state constitution of 1963 or part 25 of the revised

- 13 (i) "Traumatic injury" means a wound or the condition of the
- 14 body caused by external force, including, but not limited to, an
- 15 injury inflicted by bullet, explosive, sharp instrument, blunt
- 16 object or other physical blow, fire, smoke, chemical, electricity,
- 17 climatic condition, infectious disease, radiation, or bacteria, but
- 18 excluding an injury resulting from stress, strain, or occupational
- 19 disease.
- 20 (j) "Tuition" means tuition at the rate charged for residents
- 21 of this state.
