2 be awarded by the department to local law enforcement agencies in
3 fiscal year 2011-2012 and \$70,000,000.00 shall be awarded in fiscal
4 year 2012-2013.

5 (3) Of the \$70,000,000.00 awarded in fiscal year 2011-2012,
6 \$35,000,000.00 shall be awarded to law enforcement agencies within
7 communities under financial review or with financial managers in
8 place. The \$35,000,000.00 shall be divided according to crime rates
9 and population. The remaining \$35,000,000.00 shall be dedicated to
10 statewide public safety staff at the discretion of the department
11 of state police.

12 (4) These funds are designated as work project appropriations
13 and shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year and shall
14 continue to be available for expenditure for the purposes described
15 in this section.
