HOUSE BILL No. 5490

March 20, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Tlaib, Greimel, Smiley, Olson, Muxlow, Irwin, Liss, Kandrevas, Bauer and Rutledge and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2008 PA 429, entitled "Nonferrous metal regulatory act," by amending the title and sections 1, 3, 5, and 7 (MCL 445.421, 445.423, 445.425, and 445.427).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to regulate the purchase and sale of certain nonferrous metals; to provide for disclosures by certain persons regarding certain transactions; to require the creation of records for certain purposes and for the use of certain databases by certain persons; SCRAP METAL AND OTHER METAL ARTICLES TO SCRAP METAL DEALERS; TO REQUIRE SELLERS TO PROVIDE AND SCRAP METAL DEALERS TO OBTAIN CERTAIN INFORMATION AT THE TIME OF A PURCHASE TRANSACTION; TO REQUIRE THAT SCRAP METAL DEALERS IMPLEMENT AND MAINTAIN RECORDS OF THEIR PURCHASE TRANSACTIONS AND TO MAKE THOSE RECORDS AVAILABLE

- 1 FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES; and to provide for penalties and
- 2 remedies.
- 3 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 4 "nonferrous "SCRAP metal regulatory act".
- 5 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 6 (a) "Dealer" means any person that is not a first purchaser
- 7 who purchases nonferrous metals from any seller. Dealer includes,
- 8 but is not limited to, a person, whether or not licensed under
- 9 state law or local ordinance, that operates a business as a scrap
- 10 metal recycler, scrap processor, secondhand and junk dealer, or
- 11 other person who purchases any amount of nonferrous metal on a
- 12 regular, sporadic, or 1-time basis. Dealer does not include an
- 13 automotive recycler regulated by and complying with section 217 of
- 14 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217; section 18 of
- 15 the motor vehicle service and repair act, 1974 PA 300, MCL
- 16 257.1318; or section 2 of 1986 PA 119, MCL 257.1352, when engaging
- 17 in activities that meet the definition of automotive recycler as
- 18 defined in section 2a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300,
- 19 MCL 257.2a.
- 20 (b) "Documentation" means a signed statement that indicates
- 21 where the person obtained the article, that the person is
- 22 authorized to sell the article, or other evidence that reasonably
- 23 demonstrates ownership of the article and the source of the
- 24 article.
- 25 (c) "Ferrous metal" means a metal that contains significant
- 26 quantities of iron or steel.
- 27 (A) (d) "First purchaser" means the first buyer of a METAL

- 1 ARTICLE OR OTHER manufactured product containing nonferrous ITEM
- 2 THAT CONTAINS metal in a retail or business-to-business
- 3 transaction. Persons purchasing nonferrous metal A PERSON THAT
- 4 PURCHASES SCRAP METAL, OR OTHER PERSONAL PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN
- 5 SECTION 10, in violation of this act, OR AN automotive recyclers,
- 6 pawnshops, RECYCLER, PAWNSHOP, scrap metal recyclers, and RECYCLER,
- 7 OR scrap processors are PROCESSOR IS not considered A first
- 8 purchasers.PURCHASER.
- 9 (B) (e) "Industrial or commercial account CUSTOMER" means any
- 10 person, operating A PERSON THAT OPERATES from a fixed location 7
- 11 that AND is a seller of ferrous or nonferrous SCRAP metal to a
- 12 scrap metal recycler pursuant to DEALER UNDER a written agreement.
- 13 (f) "Nonferrous metal" means a metal that does not contain
- 14 significant quantities of ferrous metal but contains copper, brass,
- 15 platinum based metals, aluminum, bronze, lead, zinc, nickel, or
- 16 alloys of those metals.
- 17 (C) "METAL ARTICLE" MEANS A METAL ITEM, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 18 LIMITED TO, A PUBLIC FIXTURE, THAT IS USABLE FOR ITS ORIGINAL
- 19 INTENDED PURPOSE WITHOUT PROCESSING, REPAIR, OR ALTERATION, BUT IS
- 20 OFFERED FOR SALE FOR THE VALUE OF THE METAL IT CONTAINS.
- 21 (D) (g) "Person" means an individual, partnership,
- 22 corporation, limited liability company, joint venture, trust,
- 23 association, or other legal entity.
- 24 (E) (h) "Public fixtures FIXTURE" means articles containing
- 25 nonferrous metal that are A METAL ARTICLE THAT IS used or located
- 26 in areas AN AREA open to the public. and include THE TERM INCLUDES,
- 27 but are IS not limited to, A utility access covers COVER; street

- 1 light and fixtures POLE OR FIXTURE; road and OR bridge quard rails
- 2 GUARDRAIL; highway or street signs—SIGN; water meter covers—COVER;
- 3 traffic directional and OR control signs SIGN; traffic light
- 4 signals-SIGNAL; telecommunications cable; utility-related articles
- 5 METAL ARTICLE; and OR historical markers.MARKER.
- 6 (F) "PURCHASE TRANSACTION" MEANS A PURCHASE OF SCRAP METAL BY
- 7 A SCRAP METAL DEALER.
- 8 (G) (i) "Record" means a paper, electronic, or other generally
- 9 accepted method of storing information in a retrievable form.
- 10 (H) "SCRAP METAL" MEANS A METAL ARTICLE; METAL REMOVED FROM OR
- 11 OBTAINED BY CUTTING, DEMOLISHING, OR DISASSEMBLING A BUILDING,
- 12 STRUCTURE, OR MANUFACTURED ITEM; OR OTHER METAL THAT CANNOT BE USED
- 13 FOR ITS ORIGINAL INTENDED PURPOSE BUT CAN BE PROCESSED FOR REUSE IN
- 14 A MILL, FOUNDRY, OR OTHER MANUFACTURING FACILITY.
- 15 (I) "SCRAP METAL DEALER" MEANS A PERSON THAT BUYS OR SELLS
- 16 SCRAP METAL AND IS NOT A FIRST PURCHASER. THE TERM INCLUDES, BUT IS
- 17 NOT LIMITED TO, A PERSON, WHETHER OR NOT LICENSED UNDER STATE LAW
- 18 OR LOCAL ORDINANCE, THAT OPERATES A BUSINESS AS A SCRAP METAL
- 19 RECYCLER, SCRAP PROCESSOR, SECONDHAND AND JUNK DEALER, OR OTHER
- 20 PERSON THAT PURCHASES ANY AMOUNT OF SCRAP METAL ON A REGULAR,
- 21 SPORADIC, OR 1-TIME BASIS. THE TERM DOES NOT INCLUDE AN AUTOMOTIVE
- 22 RECYCLER REGULATED BY AND COMPLYING WITH SECTION 217 OF THE
- 23 MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217; SECTION 18 OF THE
- 24 MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE AND REPAIR ACT, 1974 PA 300, MCL 257.1318; OR
- 25 SECTION 2 OF 1986 PA 119, MCL 257.1352, WHEN ENGAGING IN ACTIVITIES
- 26 THAT MEET THE DEFINITION OF AUTOMOTIVE RECYCLER AS DEFINED IN
- 27 SECTION 2A OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.2A.

- 1 (j) "Scrap metal recycler" means a person that purchases
- 2 nonferrous metal that is intended for recycling or reuse, whether
- 3 regarded as a scrap processor, core buyer, or other similar
- 4 business operation.
- 5 (k) "Scrap processor" means that term as defined in section 3
- 6 of 1917 PA 350, MCL 445.403.
- 7 (1) "Seller" means any individual or A person that either
- 8 regularly, sporadically, or on a 1-time basis receives
- 9 consideration from any other person from the purchase by a SCRAP
- 10 METAL dealer of nonferrous SCRAP metal offered by that seller.
- Sec. 5. (1) A dealer shall do all ALL of the following APPLY
- 12 TO A SCRAP METAL DEALER:
- 13 (a) Produce and maintain records as required under section
- 14 $\frac{7(2)}{}$.
- 15 (b) Participate in a database meeting the requirements of
- 16 section 11.
- 17 (c) Tag and hold any nonferrous metal as provided for in
- 18 section 9.
- 19 (d) Pay a seller by a method capable of being traced from the
- 20 dealer to the seller. Payment by cash or currency of more than
- 21 \$50.00, barter, or trade is not considered a payment that complies
- 22 with the requirement of this subdivision. Payment of cash in any
- 23 amount in a transaction involving predominantly copper articles is
- 24 considered a violation of this subdivision.
- 25 (e) In the case of a transaction involving nonferrous metal,
- 26 verify that the seller is at least 16 years of age.
- 27 (A) IN A PURCHASE TRANSACTION, A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL ONLY

- 1 PAY A SELLER BY CHECK OR MONEY ORDER, MAILED WITHIN 3 BUSINESS DAYS
- 2 TO A STREET ADDRESS PROVIDED TO SCRAP METAL DEALER BY THE SELLER. A
- 3 SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL NOT MAIL AN INSTRUMENT DESCRIBED IN THIS
- 4 SECTION TO A POST OFFICE BOX AND SHALL NOT PAY ALL OR ANY PART OF
- 5 THE PURCHASE PRICE IN CASH.
- 6 (B) A SCRAP METAL DEALER IN A PURCHASE TRANSACTION SHALL NOT
- 7 ACCEPT BARTER OR A TRADE OR EXCHANGE OF SCRAP METAL OR OTHER
- 8 PERSONAL PROPERTY.
- 9 (C) A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL NOT ENTER INTO A PURCHASE
- 10 TRANSACTION IF THE SELLER, IF THE SELLER IS AN INDIVIDUAL, OR THE
- 11 INDIVIDUAL ACTING AS AN AGENT OR REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SELLER, IS
- 12 NOT AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD. A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL NOT ENTER
- 13 INTO A PURCHASE TRANSACTION WITHOUT VERIFYING THE AGE OF THAT
- 14 INDIVIDUAL.
- 15 (D) A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL NOT PURCHASE SCRAP METAL THAT
- 16 IS NOT DELIVERED IN OR ON A VEHICLE LICENSED AND TITLED FOR USE ON
- 17 PUBLIC HIGHWAYS.
- 18 (E) A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL ENSURE THAT IT PROVIDES EACH
- 19 SCALE OPERATOR, PURCHASER, AND SUPERVISOR EMPLOYED BY THE DEALER
- 20 THE TRAINING DESCRIBED IN SECTION 13 OF THE SCRAP METAL LICENSING
- 21 ACT.
- 22 (2) A seller shall do all of the following: IN A PURCHASE
- 23 TRANSACTION, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY TO A SELLER, IF THE SELLER
- 24 IS AN INDIVIDUAL, OR TO AN INDIVIDUAL ACTING AS AN AGENT OR
- 25 REPRESENTATIVE OF A SELLER:
- 26 (a) Present to the dealer HE OR SHE MUST PRESENT an operator's
- 27 or chauffeur's license, military identification card, Michigan

- 1 identification card, passport, or other government-issued
- 2 identification containing a photograph TO THE SCRAP METAL DEALER
- 3 and allow the SCRAP METAL dealer to make a photocopy or electronic
- 4 copy of the identification.
- 5 (b) Allow HE OR SHE MUST ALLOW the SCRAP METAL dealer to make
- 6 a thumbprint, to be used only for identification purposes by the
- 7 SCRAP METAL dealer and for investigation purposes by a law
- 8 enforcement agency.
- 9 (c) Execute—HE OR SHE MUST EXECUTE AND DELIVER TO THE SCRAP
- 10 METAL DEALER a signed statement indicating that the seller HE OR
- 11 SHE is the owner of, or is otherwise authorized to sell, the
- 12 nonferrous SCRAP metal offered for purchase to the SCRAP METAL
- 13 dealer.
- 14 (d) Attest to the lack of any criminal convictions AN
- 15 INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A CRIME involving the theft,
- 16 conversion, or sale of nonferrous metals.SCRAP METAL MAY NOT ENTER
- 17 INTO A PURCHASE TRANSACTION. AS PART OF A PURCHASE TRANSACTION, THE
- 18 INDIVIDUAL SHALL ATTEST THAT HE OR SHE HAS NOT BEEN CONVICTED OF A
- 19 CRIME DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBDIVISION.
- Sec. 7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
- 21 SECTION, a SCRAP METAL dealer shall produce PREPARE and maintain an
- 22 accurate and legible record of each purchase transaction. The
- 23 dealer shall maintain the records produced under DESCRIBED IN this
- 24 section for at least 1 year, shall keep the records in a location
- 25 that is readily accessible to a local, state, or federal law
- 26 enforcement agency for inspection during normal business hours, and
- 27 shall make the records, or copies of those records, available to

- 1 any local, state, or federal law enforcement agency upon THAT HAS A
- 2 reasonable suspicion of THAT A violation of this act HAS OCCURRED.
- 3 (2) The record of a purchase transaction regarding nonferrous
- 4 metal shall contain DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) MUST INCLUDE all of
- 5 the following, ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE
- 6 POLICE:
- 7 (A) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE SELLER AND THE NAME AND
- 8 ADDRESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL WHO IS DELIVERING THE SCRAP METAL IF HE
- 9 OR SHE IS NOT THE SELLER. IF AN INDIVIDUAL IS A SELLER OR
- 10 REPRESENTATIVE OF A SELLER IN MORE THAN 1 PURCHASE TRANSACTION, THE
- 11 SCRAP METAL DEALER MAY RETAIN A COPY OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S
- 12 INFORMATION OR DOCUMENT DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBDIVISION IN A SEPARATE
- 13 FILE AND USE THAT INFORMATION IN FUTURE PURCHASE TRANSACTIONS.
- 14 (B) (a)—The name, address, and identifying number from the
- 15 seller's operator's or chauffeur's license, military identification
- 16 card, Michigan identification card, passport, or other government-
- 17 issued identification containing a photograph. PRESENTED UNDER
- 18 SECTION 5(2)(A). A legible scan or photocopy of the identification
- 19 is considered satisfactory in fulfilling MEETS the requirement of
- 20 this subdivision. In the case of a repeat seller, a copy of the
- 21 information may be kept on file with the dealer and be used for IF
- 22 AN INDIVIDUAL IS A SELLER OR REPRESENTATIVE OF A SELLER IN MORE
- 23 THAN 1 PURCHASE TRANSACTION, THE SCRAP METAL DEALER MAY RETAIN A
- 24 COPY OF THE INFORMATION OR DOCUMENT DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBDIVISION
- 25 IN A SEPARATE FILE AND USE THAT INFORMATION IN future PURCHASE
- 26 transactions.
- 27 (C) (b) The license plate number of the vehicle delivering the

- 1 nonferrous metal. THAT DELIVERED THE SCRAP METAL.
- 2 (D) (c) The date and time of the **PURCHASE** transaction.
- 3 (E) (d) A description of the predominant types of SCRAP metal
- 4 purchases, PURCHASED, made in accordance with the custom of the
- 5 trade.
- 6 (F) (e) The weight, quantity, or volume of metal, made THE
- 7 SCRAP METAL PURCHASED, DESCRIBED AND CALCULATED in accordance with
- 8 the custom of the trade, AND THE NAME OF THE EMPLOYEE OF THE SCRAP
- 9 METAL DEALER WHO WEIGHS AND INSPECTS THAT PROPERTY.
- 10 (G) A PHOTOGRAPH OF THE SCRAP METAL PURCHASED.
- 11 (H) (f) The consideration paid and the method of payment.
- 12 (I) (g) A THE signed statement from the seller that the seller
- 13 is the owner of the metal or is otherwise authorized to sell the
- 14 metal subject to the transaction. DESCRIBED IN SECTION 5(2)(C).
- 15 (J) (h)—A LEGIBLE thumbprint of the seller.DESCRIBED IN
- 16 SECTION 5(2)(B).
- 17 (3) In the case of a seller that is A SCRAP METAL DEALER SHALL
- 18 RETAIN THE ORIGINAL OF THE COMPLETED RECORD FORM PREPARED UNDER
- 19 SUBSECTION (2) AND PROVIDE THE SELLER A COPY OF THAT COMPLETED
- 20 FORM.
- 21 (4) A SCRAP METAL DEALER IS NOT REQUIRED TO OBTAIN ALL OF THE
- 22 INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2) AND COMPLETE THE RECORD
- 23 FORM DESCRIBED IN THAT SUBSECTION FOR A PURCHASE TRANSACTION WITH
- 24 an industrial or commercial account where payment is made by a
- 25 method capable of being traced from the dealer to the seller and
- 26 payment is made CUSTOMER THAT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 27 (A) PAYMENT IS MADE directly to the business, the dealer is

- 1 not required to produce the record described in subsection (2) so
- 2 long as the INDUSTRIAL OR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMER.
- 3 (B) THE personal and business identifying information of the
- 4 industrial or commercial account seller CUSTOMER is on file with
- 5 the SCRAP dealer and conforms to a written description of the type
- 6 of nonferrous-SCRAP metal or articles—customarily purchased by the
- 7 SCRAP METAL dealer from that seller, and the information CUSTOMER.
- 8 (C) THE INFORMATION ON FILE WITH THE SCRAP METAL DEALER UNDER
- 9 SUBDIVISION (B) is periodically reviewed at least every 2 years and
- 10 validated as current or updated by the SCRAP METAL dealer.
- 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 12 unless all of the following bills of the 96th Legislature are
- 13 enacted into law:
- 14 (a) Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 5491(request no.
