

HOUSE BILL No. 5521

March 29, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Howze, Stallworth, Stapleton, Hobbs, Liss, Haugh, Lane, Darany, Brown, Talabi, Constan, Barnett, Geiss, Cavanagh, Hovey-Wright, Womack, Segal, Rutledge, Durhal, Hooker, Nathan, Bauer, Hammel, Bledsoe, Potvin, Roy Schmidt, Gilbert, Wayne Schmidt and Yonker and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding sections 1180, 1181, 1182, and
1183.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1180. (1) NOT LATER THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
2 DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
3 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC
4 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT A POLICY FOR THE HANDLING
5 OF MEDICAL EMERGENCIES THAT OCCUR AT SCHOOL. SCHOOL DISTRICTS,
6 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES ARE
7 ENCOURAGED TO WORK WITH LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDERS TO
8 ENSURE THAT FIRST RESPONDERS HAVE ACCESS TO DETAILED INFORMATION ON
9 AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH THE LAYOUT FOR EACH SCHOOL. THE DETAILED
10 INFORMATION SHALL INCLUDE A DESIGNATED EMERGENCY ENTRANCE WHERE

1 EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL CAN DIRECT THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL FIRST
2 RESPONDERS TO THE APPROPRIATE LOCATION IN THE SCHOOL BUILDING.

3 (2) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
4 DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL
5 POST ON ITS WEBSITE AND UPDATE AT LEAST ANNUALLY ALL OF THE
6 FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

7 (A) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF MEMBERS WORKING AT
8 EACH SCHOOL OPERATED BY THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

9 (B) THE TOTAL NUMBER OF INSTRUCTIONAL STAFF MEMBERS WORKING AT
10 EACH SCHOOL OPERATED BY THE BOARD OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS WHO HOLD
11 VALID CERTIFICATION IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION ISSUED BY THE
12 AMERICAN RED CROSS, AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A COMPARABLE
13 ORGANIZATION.

14 (3) SCHOOL DISTRICTS, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND
15 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES ARE ENCOURAGED TO WORK WITH THE AMERICAN
16 RED CROSS, AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS, OR
17 OTHER CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING PROVIDERS TO OBTAIN
18 TRAINING IN CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION FOR STAFF AND PUPILS.

19 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "AT SCHOOL" MEANS THAT TERM AS
20 DEFINED IN SECTION 1308.

21 SEC. 1181. BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2012, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE
22 PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
23 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC
24 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH INDIVIDUAL THAT THE SCHOOL
25 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY
26 EMPLOYS OR ASSIGNS TO WORK IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION OR ATHLETICS AT A
27 SCHOOL THAT IT OPERATES HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A COURSE

1 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY
2 RESUSCITATION, INCLUDING A TEST DEMONSTRATION ON A MANNEQUIN; HAS
3 SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED INSTRUCTION APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT IN
4 FOREIGN BODY AIRWAY OBSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT; AND HOLDS VALID
5 CERTIFICATION IN THESE TOPICS ISSUED BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS,
6 AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A COMPARABLE ORGANIZATION OR
7 INSTITUTION APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT. A SCHOOL DISTRICT,
8 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL
9 PROVIDE THE TRAINING NECESSARY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION
10 OR SHALL ARRANGE FOR THE PROVISION OF THIS TRAINING AT NO COST TO
11 THE INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING THE TRAINING.

12 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED OR
13 ASSIGNED TO WORK IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION OR ATHLETICS IF THE
14 INDIVIDUAL HAS PHYSICAL LIMITATIONS THAT MAKE IT IMPRACTICABLE FOR
15 THE INDIVIDUAL TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING AND OBTAIN THE REQUIRED
16 CERTIFICATION UNDER SUBSECTION (1).

17 (3) THE LEGISLATURE SHALL APPROPRIATE FUNDS AS NECESSARY TO
18 REIMBURSE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND
19 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES FOR THE COSTS OF THE TRAINING AND
20 CERTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (1).

21 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "WORK IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION OR
22 ATHLETICS" MEANS TO BE EMPLOYED AS A TEACHER OR AIDE FOR PHYSICAL
23 EDUCATION OR TO ACT AS A COACH, TRAINER, OR OTHER MEMBER OF THE
24 STAFF FOR AN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS TEAM, CONTEST, COMPETITION,
25 TOURNAMENT, MEET, OR PRACTICE.

26 SEC. 1182. BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2012, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL
27 DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A

1 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
2 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY MAINTAINS IN
3 A SECURE MANNER FOR EACH PUPIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

4 (A) EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION.

5 (B) MEDICAL BACKGROUND AND HISTORY.

6 SEC. 1183. BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2012, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL
7 DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A
8 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

9 (A) THAT AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IS PRESENT AT
10 EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IT OPERATES AND THAT THE AUTOMATED EXTERNAL
11 DEFIBRILLATOR IS READILY ACCESSIBLE DURING SCHOOL HOURS TO STAFF,
12 PUPILS, VOLUNTEERS, AND GUESTS.

13 (B) THAT AN AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR IS PRESENT AND
14 READILY ACCESSIBLE WITHIN 50 FEET OF ANY ATHLETIC ACTIVITY OR EVENT
15 SPONSORED OR PERMITTED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
16 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.
