

# HOUSE BILL No. 5561

April 24, 2012, Introduced by Rep. LeBlanc and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled "Emergency 9-1-1 service enabling act," by amending section 406 (MCL 484.1406), as amended by 2007 PA 165.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 406. (1) The funds collected and expended under this act  
2 shall be expended exclusively for 9-1-1 services and in compliance  
3 with the rules promulgated under section 413.

4           (2) Each PSAP or secondary PSAP shall assure that fund  
5 accounting, auditing, monitoring, and evaluation procedures are  
6 provided as required by this act and the rules promulgated under  
7 this act.

8           (3) An annual audit shall be conducted **FOR EACH PSAP AND**

1 **SECONDARY PSAP** by an independent auditor using generally accepted  
2 accounting principles. ~~and copies~~ **COPIES** of the annual audit shall  
3 be made available for public inspection.

4 (4) An increase in the charges allowed under this act shall  
5 not be authorized or expended for the next fiscal year unless,  
6 according to the most recently completed annual audit **CONDUCTED**  
7 **UNDER SUBSECTION (3)**, the expenditures are in compliance with this  
8 act.

9 (5) The receipt of 9-1-1 funds under this act is dependent on  
10 compliance with the standards established by the commission under  
11 section 413.
