A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled "The insurance code of 1956,"

by amending section 3113 (MCL 500.3113), as amended by 1986 PA 93.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3113. A person is not entitled to be paid personal
 protection insurance benefits UNDER THIS CHAPTER for accidental
 bodily injury if at the time of the accident any of the following
- 4 circumstances existed:
 - (a) The person was using a motor vehicle or motorcycle which **THAT** he or she had taken unlawfully, unless the person reasonably believed that he or she was entitled to take and use the vehicle.
 - (B) THE PERSON WAS A PASSENGER IN A MOTOR VEHICLE OR ON A MOTORCYCLE THAT WAS TAKEN UNLAWFULLY, IF THE PERSON KNEW OF HAD REASON TO BELIEVE THAT THE MOTOR VEHICLE OR MOTORCYCLE WAS
