A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled
 "Michigan election law,"
 by amending section 936 (MCL 168.936).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 ~~Sec. 936. Any person found guilty of perjury under the~~
 2 ~~provisions of this act shall, unless herein otherwise provided, be~~
 3 ~~punished by a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00, or by imprisonment in~~
 4 ~~the state prison for a term not exceeding 5 years, or by both such~~
 5 ~~fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.~~ EXCEPT AS
 6 OTHERWISE PROVIDED, A PERSON CONVICTED OF PERJURY UNDER THIS ACT IS
 7 GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5
 8 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
