- 1 (A) THE WILDLIFE POPULATIONS OF THE STATE AND THEIR HABITAT
- 2 ARE OF PARAMOUNT IMPORTANCE TO THE CITIZENS OF THIS STATE.
- 3 (B) THE SOUND SCIENTIFIC MANAGEMENT OF GRAY WOLF POPULATIONS
- 4 IN THIS STATE IS NECESSARY, INCLUDING THE USE OF HUNTING AS A

- Sec. 43503. (1) "Fish" means all species of fish.
- 13 (2) "Fishing" means the pursuing, capturing, catching,
- 14 killing, or taking of fish, and includes attempting to pursue,
- 15 capture, catch, kill, or take fish.
- 16 (3) "Firearm" means a weapon from which a dangerous projectile
- 17 may be propelled by using explosives, gas, or air as a means of
- 18 propulsion. Firearm does not include a smooth bore rifle or handqun
- 19 designed and manufactured exclusively for propelling BB's not
- 20 exceeding .177 caliber by means of a spring or air or gas.
