(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 558a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 558A. IF A CANDIDATE FILES NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR A
- 2 FEDERAL, STATE, COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, VILLAGE, OR SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 3 OFFICE, THE CANDIDATE SHALL FILE WITH THE OFFICER WITH WHOM THE
- 4 NOMINATING PETITIONS ARE FILED A SIGNED AFFIDAVIT ATTESTING TO THE
- 5 FACT THAT THE CANDIDATE HAS REVIEWED THE SIGNATURES ON THE
- 6 NOMINATING PETITIONS AND THAT TO THE BEST OF HIS OR HER KNOWLEDGE
- 7 THE SIGNATURES ON THE NOMINATING PETITIONS WERE COLLECTED IN
- 8 ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW AND ARE VALID.
