## **HOUSE BILL No. 5958**

September 27, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Bumstead and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 268, entitled "Legislative council act,"

by amending section 1702 (MCL 4.1702), as added by 1987 PA 123.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1702. (1) The Michigan capitol committee shall advise and
- 2 make recommendations to the governor, the senate majority leader,
- 3 and the speaker of the house of representatives MICHIGAN CAPITOL
- 4 STATE PARK COMMISSION regarding the restoration and preservation of
- 5 the state capitol building and the management, operation,
- 6 development, construction, renovation, maintenance, and repair of
- the state capitol building and THE grounds OF THE MICHIGAN CAPITOL
  - STATE PARK. Such recommendations RECOMMENDATIONS UNDER THIS

- 21 space in the capitol building OR THE CAPITOL BUILDING PARKING LOT,
- 22 and on the grounds, including legislative or staff offices. All
- 23 decisions concerning such-space IN THE CAPITOL BUILDING AND THE
