HOUSE BILL No. 5961

October 17, 2012, Introduced by Rep. LeBlanc and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 2011 PA 256, entitled

"Michigan fireworks safety act,"

by amending sections 4 and 5 (MCL 28.454 and 28.455), section 4 as amended by 2012 PA 257.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) A person shall not sell consumer fireworks unless
- 2 the person annually obtains and maintains a consumer fireworks
- 3 certificate from the department under this section. A person who
- 4 knows, or should know, that he or she is required to comply with
- 5 this subsection and who fails or neglects to do so is guilty of a
- 6 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years or
- 7 a fine, or both, with the fine as follows:
- 8 (a) For a first violation of this subsection, not more than
- \$5,000.00.

- 1 (b) For a second violation of this subsection, not more than
- **2** \$20,000.00.
- 3 (c) For a third or subsequent violation of this subsection,
- 4 not more than \$40,000.00.
- 5 (2) An application for a consumer fireworks certificate shall
- 6 meet all of the following requirements:
- 7 (a) Before January 1, 2012, the application shall be submitted
- 8 not less than 90 days before the applicant sells consumer
- 9 fireworks.
- 10 (b) Beginning January 1, 2012, the application shall be
- 11 submitted no later than April 1 of each year in which consumer
- 12 fireworks are to be sold.
- 13 (c) The application shall list the name and address of each
- 14 retail location from which consumer fireworks are to be sold.
- 15 (d) Until January 1, 2014, the application shall be
- 16 accompanied by a fee of \$1,000.00 for a certificate for each retail
- 17 location that is a permanent building or structure or, UNTIL
- 18 JANUARY 1, 2014, \$600.00 for each retail location that is not a
- 19 permanent building or structure. Until January 1, 2014, the
- 20 fireworks certificate fee required to be paid for a retail location
- 21 that is not a permanent building or structure shall not exceed 60%
- 22 of the fireworks certificate fee for a retail location that is a
- 23 permanent building or structure.
- 24 (e) The application shall be accompanied by a copy of the
- 25 applicant's current sales tax license, including the applicant's
- 26 account number, issued by the department of treasury for each
- 27 retail location where consumer fireworks are to be sold by the

- 1 applicant.
- 2 (3) A consumer fireworks certificate issued under this section
- 3 is valid from the date of issue until April 30 of the year after it
- 4 was issued. A person may renew a consumer fireworks certificate for
- 5 a retail location by making application in the same manner as
- 6 provided under subsection (2). However, the department shall not
- 7 issue a renewal consumer fireworks certificate unless the
- 8 department determines that the applicant properly remitted all of
- 9 the fireworks safety fees required to be paid in the preceding
- 10 year. The department shall provide to the department of treasury
- 11 the sales tax license information received from the applicant and
- 12 any additional information as may be necessary to allow the
- 13 department of treasury to confirm that each sales tax license
- 14 submitted by the applicant is current and valid. The department
- 15 shall enter into an agreement with the department of treasury under
- 16 section 28(1) of 1941 PA 122, MCL 205.28, that will allow the
- 17 department of treasury to provide that information to the
- 18 department. The department shall not issue an original or renewal
- 19 consumer fireworks certificate to an applicant until the department
- 20 of treasury has confirmed to the department that each sales tax
- 21 license submitted by the applicant is current and valid, and that
- 22 the applicant is otherwise eligible to obtain a consumer fireworks
- 23 certificate under this act.
- 24 (4) Not more than 30 days after an application is submitted to
- 25 the department under this section, the department shall issue or
- 26 deny issuance of a consumer fireworks certificate to the applicant
- 27 and, if issuance is denied, shall indicate to the applicant the

- 1 reason for denial.
- 2 (5) If the department denies issuance of a consumer fireworks
- 3 certificate under this section, the applicant may cure any defect
- 4 of the application within 45 days after the denial without paying
- 5 an additional fee. The department shall not unreasonably delay or
- 6 deny an application under this section.
- 7 (6) A consumer fireworks certificate is transferable upon
- 8 approval by the department and the payment of a \$25.00 transfer
- 9 fee. However, the department shall not approve the transfer of a
- 10 consumer fireworks certificate unless the transferee satisfies
- 11 eliqibility requirements for an original consumer fireworks
- 12 certificate under this act.
- 13 (7) The holder of a consumer fireworks certificate shall
- 14 prominently display the original or copy of the certificate in the
- 15 appropriate retail location. A person that violates this subsection
- 16 is responsible for a civil fine of \$100.00. Each day that the
- 17 consumer fireworks certificate is not displayed as required under
- 18 this subsection is a separate violation.
- 19 (8) The department shall not issue a consumer fireworks
- 20 certificate to a person that is ineligible under this act.
- 21 (9) The face of the consumer fireworks certificate shall
- 22 indicate the location or address for which it was issued.
- 23 (10) Fees collected under this section shall be deposited in
- 24 the fireworks safety fund.
- Sec. 5. (1) Consumer fireworks shall only be sold from a
- 26 retail location if all of the following applicable conditions are

27 met.:

- 1 (a) Except as provided in subdivision (b), a retail location
- 2 satisfies the applicable requirements of NFPA 101 and NFPA 1124 not
- 3 in conflict with this act.
- 4 (b) Beginning 1 year after the effective date of this act
- 5 JANUARY 1, 2012, a permanent building or structure shall be
- 6 equipped with a fire suppression system in compliance with NFPA
- **7** 1124.
- 8 (c) The retailer at that retail location is licensed under
- 9 section 3 of the general sales tax act, 1933 PA 167, MCL 205.53.
- 10 (d) The retailer has a valid federal taxpayer identification
- 11 number issued by the federal department of the treasury, internal
- 12 revenue service. This requirement does not apply to a retailer that
- is a sole proprietorship.
- 14 (E) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2014, THE RETAIL LOCATION IS A
- 15 PERMANENT BUILDING OR STRUCTURE.
- 16 (2) A person that knows, or should know, that he or she is
- 17 required to comply with subsection (1) and who fails or neglects to
- 18 do so is responsible for a civil fine of \$2,500.00 for each
- 19 violation. Each day that a person is in noncompliance constitutes a
- 20 separate violation.
- 21 (3) During periods when consumer fireworks are sold, each
- 22 retail location selling consumer fireworks either shall be added as
- 23 an additional insured, or public liability and product liability
- 24 insurance coverage shall be obtained and maintained, in an amount
- 25 not less than \$10,000,000.00 per occurrence. A person that knows,
- 26 or should know, that he or she is required to comply with this
- 27 subsection and who fails or neglects to do so is liable for a civil

1 fine of not more than \$5,000.00.

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
