HOUSE BILL No. 6003

November 8, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled

"Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 28.304).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) The secretary of state may issue an enhanced
- 2 driver's license or enhanced official state personal identification
- 3 card to an applicant who provides satisfactory proof of his or her
- 4 full legal name, United States citizenship, identity, date of
- 5 birth, social security number, residence address, and a
- 5 photographic identity document. An applicant may choose to apply
- 7 for a standard driver license or standard official state personal
- 8 identification card or an enhanced driver license or enhanced state
- 9 personal identification card.
 - (2) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state

- 1 personal identification card shall include reasonable security
- 2 measures to protect against unauthorized disclosure of personal
- 3 information regarding residents of this state that is contained in
- 4 the enhanced driver license or enhanced official state personal
- 5 identification card.
- 6 (3) An enhanced driver license or enhanced official state
- 7 personal identification card may include radio frequency
- 8 identification technology that is limited to a randomly assigned
- 9 number which shall be encrypted if agreed to by the department of
- 10 homeland security, and does not include biometric data. The
- 11 secretary of state shall ensure that the radio frequency
- 12 identification technology is secure from unauthorized data access
- 13 and includes reasonable security measures to protect against
- 14 unauthorized disclosure of personal information. An applicant shall
- 15 be required to sign a declaration acknowledging his or her
- 16 understanding of the radio frequency identification technology
- 17 before he or she is issued an enhanced driver license or enhanced
- 18 official state personal identification card.
- 19 (4) The requirements of this act are in addition to the
- 20 requirements otherwise imposed on individuals who apply for a
- 21 standard driver license or standard official state personal
- 22 identification card.
- 23 (5) The holder of an enhanced driver license issued under this
- 24 act is subject to every licensing sanction provided under the
- 25 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923. As used
- 26 in this subsection, "licensing sanction" means the restriction,
- 27 suspension, revocation, or denial of a driver license; the addition

- 1 of points to a driving record; the assessment of a driver
- 2 responsibility fee; the assessment of a civil fine or criminal
- 3 penalty resulting from a conviction; a civil infraction
- 4 determination; the imposition of probationary terms and conditions;
- 5 or any other penalty provided under the Michigan vehicle code, 1949
- 6 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923.
- 7 (6) A PERSON SHALL NOT DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) INTENTIONALLY OBTAIN OR ATTEMPT TO OBTAIN ENCRYPTED DATA
- 9 FROM AN ENHANCED DRIVER LICENSE OR ENHANCED OFFICIAL STATE PERSONAL
- 10 IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR READ OR OTHERWISE ACCESS THAT DATA WITHOUT
- 11 THE KNOWLEDGE AND CONSENT OF THE LICENSEE OR CARD HOLDER.
- 12 (B) SELL OR OTHERWISE DISTRIBUTE OR ATTEMPT TO SELL OR
- 13 OTHERWISE DISTRIBUTE DATA HE OR SHE KNOWS WAS OBTAINED IN VIOLATION
- 14 OF SUBDIVISION (A).
- 15 (C) POSSESS OR ATTEMPT TO POSSESS DATA HE OR SHE KNOWS WAS
- 16 OBTAINED IN VIOLATION OF SUBDIVISION (A).
- 17 (7) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (6) IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
- 18 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE OF
- 19 NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
